1. Your tender for the work mentioned above is hereby accepted on behalf of chairman, Airports Authority of India at an amount of **₹. 4,98,50,694.00 (Rupees Four Crores Ninety-Eight Lakhs Fifty Thousand Six Hundred & Ninety-Four only) (Excluding GST)**. The amount is 5.17% below the justified cost of ₹. 5,25,69,338/- (Rupees Five Crores Twenty-Five Lakhs Sixty-Nine Thousand Three Hundred and Thirty-Eight Only)
2. The time period for execution of work is 02 (Two) years with effect from 01.01. 2021. The contract period can be extended further for a period of one year, subject to satisfactory performance with same rate and terms & conditions.
3. SM (OPS), AAI, Trichy Airport, Trichy shall be the in-charge of the work. You are requested to attend the office of the Airport Director, AAI, Trichy Airport within 7 (seven) days from the date of issue of this order to sign and complete the contract agreement. The contract agreement shall be executed on a judicial stamp paper of value ₹. 100.00/- (Rupees One Hundred Only) and the cost of the stamp shall be borne you. This award letter will form part of the agreement.
4. Please deposit **₹. 24,92,535/- (Rupees Twenty-Four Lakhs Ninety-Two Thousand Five Hundred and Thirty-Five Only)** in the form of Bank Guarantee drawn on any Nationalized Scheduled Bank in absolute favour of the "Airport Director, AAI, Trichy Airport" Payable at Trichy towards Performance Guarantee within a period of 30 days from the issue of this letter. Interest @ 18% per annum on performance guarantee amount would be levied (non-refundable) for delayed period of submission.

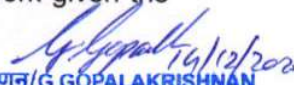

5. The agency shall permit AAI at the time of making any payment to him for work done under the contract to deduct a sum at the rate of 5% of the gross amount of each running bill till the sum along with the sum already deposited as earnest money, will amount to security deposit of 5% of the tendered value of the work. Earnest money shall be adjusted first in the security deposit and further recovery of security deposit starts exceeding the earnest money. Such deductions will be made and held by way of Security Deposit unless he/they/has/have deposited the amount of Security at the rate mentioned above in the form of Bank Guarantee, NEFT or guarantee bonds of Nationalized Bank or any Scheduled Bank but not Co-operative or Garmin Bank.
6. The contractor shall be required to deploy the minimum machinery / equipment as per clause SCC 13.1 & 13.2, Biometric attendance system SCC 13.2.1, Other equipment's/tools/accessories as per SCC 28.1, Chemicals and consumables as per SCC 28.3 and 28.3.1, cleaning of tools and consumables as per SCC 28.4 and 28.5, Minimum manpower as per SCC 29.2 and Uniform as per clause SCC 29.5, facility officer/Manager of 01. No as per SCC 42.9 failing which the penalty shall be imposed as per the relevant clauses. The deployment has to be in consultation with the In-Charge of the work.
7. The Contractor has to submit third party insurances as per clause SCC 11 712 AMC status for all machinery as per clause SCC 14.6.4 shall submit actual monthly consumption quantity of consumables, shall provide manpower and training levels as per SCC 42.9, shall place a SOP for checking cleanliness standard as per clause SCC 42.13 failing which the respective penalty clause shall be evoked.
8. The contractor has to ensure the cleaning frequency as specified in the scope of work SCC 29.1 and also ensure the required cleanliness standard (ASQ rating of 4.68 as on date) as per SCC 39.
9. The contractor has to ensure timely check and placement of the consumable of approved quality as specified in clause SCC 28.3 and ensure cleanliness of the terminal premises, any compliant received shall attract the penalty as per the relevant clause specified.
10. The contractor has to arrange all the machineries as per clause SCC 13.1 & 13.2 (as per corrigendum 4) and to be positioned in respective places before commencement of work.
11. The Contractor is required to make payments to all the persons employed by them for this work as prescribed under the Minimum Wages Act and all the related statutory provisions applicable there to on or before 7th of every month failing which shall attract penalty as per SCC 5.3.
12. Work shall be carried out as per the terms and conditions and scope of work given the contract.

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13. You are requested to comply with the provision of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 and Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Central rules 1971 and minimum wages and rules thereof Central and State Governments.
14. The contractor will be required to abide by all applicable labour laws. The contractor shall display "Labour Board" as per GCC Appendix III vide Page No. 68.
15. The agency has to continue to deploy the existing manpower as per the "Status quo" order of High Court of Madras.
16. The Contractor has to obtain labour license as per the relevant act before commencement of the work.
17. The charges for insurance of PIC /AEP etc., if any shall be borne by the contractor. No labour shall be allowed to enter in the Airport premises without valid PIC/AEP.
18. The contractor shall abide by all the terms and conditions, Rules and Regulations of AAI as may be enforced from time to time.
19. You are also directed to contact SM (OPS), AAI, Trichy Airport immediately who will arrange to hand over the site to you.
20. Any further correspondence in connection with the contract should normally be addressed to the SM (OPS), AAI, Trichy Airport.
21. The Workers shall subject themselves to physical verification and frisking while entering or leaving the airport premises or at any time while on duty by the authorized representative of the authority or any other security agency appointed for the purpose.
22. The Authorized representative shall report to Senior Manager (OPS) to submit the sheet showing deployment of labourers and for any other specific instructions on daily basis.
23. Any damages caused to AAI property while executing the work shall be viewed seriously and the same will be recovered from contractor 's Payments.
24. The bill in triplicate shall be submitted for payment of all running bills.
25. This work order is allotted he number AAI/TRY/MESS/2020-21 dated 11.12.2020 which shall be quoted by you for all future correspondence in connection with this work order.
