



Summary & Recommendation

We have done the evaluation of the documents submitted by the Bidders in response to the Request for proposal as floated by the Authority and found that all the bidders have submitted their bid within the time as stipulated by the Authority, paid the requisite cost of the document and bid security in the form of bank guarantee.

On the basis of our evaluation of the eligibility of the Bids and the subsequent replies to clarifications received from the Bidder, in pursuance of Clause 3 & 4 of the RFP, the summary of our evaluation is provided hereunder;

Sr. No	Name of the Applicant	Remarks
1	M/s GR Engineer & Contractors	As per clause 4.6 of RFP, Bidders who meet the minimum qualification criteria will be qualified only if their available bid capacity is more than the total bid value i.e Rs 9.62 cr. When calculated the Assessed Bid Capacity of M/s GR Engineer & Contractors comes to Rs. 4.12 Crores which is way below the requisite Bid Capacity of atleast Rs. 9.62 Crores. Thus, the Bidder fails to fulfil the qualification requirements for the project as per clause 4.6 of the RFP, and becomes in-eligible for the any further stages of Bidding in this project.
2	M/s Mahavir Prasad Gupta & Sons	The Bidder fulfills all the requirements for the Project and is therefore, technically responsive.
3	M/s SEC Buildtech Private Limited	The Bidder fulfills all the requirements for the Project and is therefore, technically responsive.

Now in pursuance of Clause 23.5 of the Instructions to the Bidder of RFP, It is hereby recommended that the the Authority may publish a list of above Technically Responsive Bidders whose financial bids shall be opened.
