Technically Non-Responsive	The bidder has claimed 13 (A to M) projects in submission of technical bid and for project code G to M fails to meet the minimum requirements of eligibility under category 3 & 4 as per clause 2.2.2.6 (ii) of the RFP, which specifically requires that the receipts of or work executed amount less than Rs. 6.19 crore (Rs. Six Crore and Nineteen lakh only) shall not be reckoned as receipts for Eligible Projects. The same has been forwarded to bidder for clarification through letter dated 18.11.2020 however bidder failed to submit any replies in response to requirement under clause 2.2.2.6 (ii) of the RFP. Hence, In the absence of any response these projects cannot be consider for evaluation. Accordingly, The Bidder does not meet the Technical Capacity criteria as required under clause 2.2.2.2 (i) of Rs 61.87 crore. Assessed Aggregate Technical Experience Score of the Bidder is only Rs 27.80 Cr. against the requirement of Rs 61.87 Cr..In view of this the bidder is Technically Non-Responsive.

M/s E5 Infrastructure Private Limited	Technically Non-Responsive	As per clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) of RFP, "The sole Bidder shall have completed at least one similar Major Bridge/ROB/Flyover project in the last 5 (Five) financial years preceding the Bid Due Date, having span equal to or greater than 16.25 m and also the cost of such similar project shall be at least. Rs 15.47 crore. For this purpose, a project shall be considered to be completed, if more than 90% of the value of work has been completed and such completed value of work is equal to or more than Rs 15.47 crore". The Bidder has not claimed any single project as similar capacity project as required under Clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) of the RFP as eligibility criteria for Technical Capacity. Further, during our evaluation it was observed that none of the Projects claimed by the Bidder in the Technical Experience under Annex – IV demonstrates completion/ substantial completion of a similar nature work of construction of a Major Bridge/ Flyover/ ROB Project. These queries has been forwarded to bidder for clarification vide letter dated 18.11.2020. Bidder in its clarification has submitted that claimed project code B is a similar nature work within the definition of clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) of the RFP. Futher, bidder in support of his claim also submitted the copy of Schedule B & H which was executed between Gawar Construction Limited and NHAI.

			Reply of the bidder is not tenable as there is no submission of the Agreement which was entered between the Bidder and Gawar Construction Limited instead submitted copy of Schedule B & H which was executed between Gawar Construction Limited and NHAI. Further, bidder also submitted a certificate issued by PD Rajkot. however, there is no mention about the completion of Major Bridge/ROB/Flyover project in the last 5 (Five) financial years preceding the Bid Due Date, having span equal to or greater than 16.25 m and also the cost of such similar project shall be at least. Rs 15.47 crore. Also there is no certificate from Gawar Construction Limited who employed the bidder for this project. Accordingly, Bidder does not meet the criteria of span equal to or greater than 16.25 m and also the cost of such similar project shall be at least. Rs 15.47 crore as required in clause 2.2.2.2(iii) of RFP. In view of this the bidder is Technically Non-Responsive.
6.	M/s KNR Contractors Private Limited	Technically Non-Responsive	The bidder has claimed total 6 projects. However project C & F are classified as RIDF project under NABARD's Administrative sanction. Hence, fails to qualify under Category 3 as per clause 2.2.2.5 (iii)(b)(V) of the RFP. The same has been forwarded to bidder for clarification vide letter dated 18.11.2020. The Bidder in its replies has claimed that it is unaware of the fact whether the Project Code C is a RIDF Funded project or not. However from the bid documents submitted both the project clearly cites the reference of NABARD RIDF Administrative sanction. Further, for project code A & E it was not established whether the claimed projects are National Highway/ State Highway Project. The same has been forwarded to bidder for clarification vide letter dated 18.11.2020. For Project Code A & E the bidder has clarified that Project code A involves construction of State Highway and was funded under State Government Budgetary funding. However, if clarifications of the bidder related to Project Code A, E, & C are considered even then it does not meet the Technical Capacity criteria as required under clause 2.2.2.2 (i) of Rs 61.87 crore. As the receipts and payments for the projects code F are Rs.6.17 cr against the requirement of Rs. 6.19 cr as mentioned in clause 2.2.2.6(ii) of RFP, so the project not considered in evaluation. Accordingly, the Bidder does not meet the Technical Capacity criteria as required under clause 2.2.2.2 (i) of Rs 61.87 crore. Assessed Aggregate Technical Experience Score of the Bidder is only Rs 59.45Cr. Against the requirement of Rs 61.87 Cr. In view of this the bidder is Technically Non-Responsive
