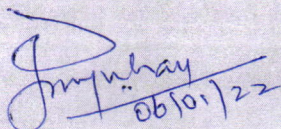


Financial bid opened on 21.12.21 and M/s Bahuchar Corporation became L1 . But it is observed that the rate quoted by this firm for different models of the HP cartridges are (our maximum required model) unusually low and comes within a discounted price of 70 % to 90 % compared to the rate shown in official HP website. Eg; for HP 80X model cartridge is offered by the firm for a price of Rs. 1600/- excluding GST where as the rate shown in the HP web site for the same item is Rs. 15883/-. ie; at a discount of 90 % . On enquiry from the local market revealed that supply of the items of a reputed brand in such a low price is not at all viable and the genuinity is suspected.

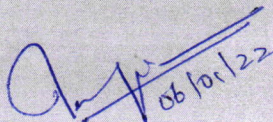
On Inquiry from M/S HP and as per the intimation given by them, M/S Bahuchar Corporation, the L1 Bidder is not the authorised supplier of HP products and the OEM certificate submitted is fake. On telephonic query from the sales head of HP it is further intimated that the L2 Bidder M/S Navkar Infomedia is also not an authorised vendor of HP and their OEM Certificate also is fake. M/S Cyber Technologies , the L3 Bidder is the genuine Vendor of HP

Hence it is recommended to reject the L1 bid and do a Retender action.



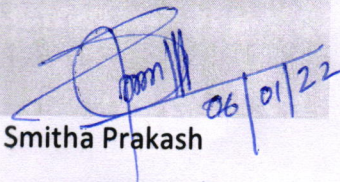
