The online Tender was invited for an amount Rs. 3,55,48,356/-excluding GST at 12% vide above said notification for the subject work and for which the following bidders have submitted the Technical Proposals on the scheduled date of 14.09.2021 and the same were opened by the Bid Evaluation Committee on 15.09.2021.

2. B.G Arvind,
3. M Sanjeevaraju,
4. ArjunvaisnaviInfrastructure and Development Pvt Ltd,
5. PR and Co Engineers and Contractors,
6. S T Ramesh (Ganapathi Stone Crusher)

As per recommendations of Bid Evaluation Committee vide Technical Minutes cited 2nd above, out of 07 (Seven) bidders only Two (02) bidders namely 1) S T Ramesh (Ganapathi Stone Crusher) 2) M/s. Arjunvaishnavi Infrastructure & Development Pvt. Ltd. are considered Technically Responsive Competent Authority has accorded approval for opening of the Financial bids of the technically responsive bidders.

Accordingly the Bid Evaluation Committee has opened the Financial Bids on 25.10.2021. The details of Financial proposals are as below:

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As per NHAI Policy Matters-Technical (209-2016) No.NHAI/CM-1/Misc./2016 dt.02.08.2016 and in which vide sl. No. D (i) states that the Regional Officer has been delegated for power of approval for the bids for Maintenance works, where the lowest bid price is upto 5% above.

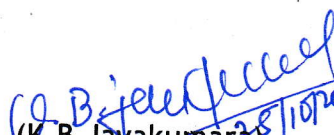
Since, the percentage quoted by the L1 bidder S T Ramesh (Ganapathi Stone Crusher) is (+) 0.005% above and which works out to Rs. 3,55,50,002.68/- Plus 12% GST as against the Contract amount of Rs. 3,55,48,356 /- Plus 12% GST and as such it comes within the delegation powers of RO.

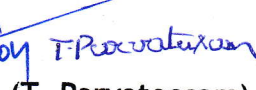
As per Section-II vide clause 33.1 of RFP, the selected bidder has to submit Performance Security at 03% of the Contract price within 10 days after receipt of the LOA.

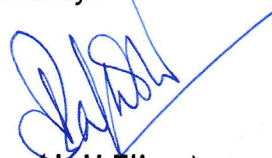
Conclusion of Committee:

In the view of the findings of the Bid evaluation committee recommends to approval financial evaluation and issue LOA As per Section-II vide clause 33.1 of RFP to L1 bidder S T Ramesh (Ganapathi Stone Crusher) for the quoted amount of Rs. 3,55,50,002.68/- plus 12% GST to the approval of Competent Authority.
