Sub: Construction of LVUP at Nangali cross @ CH.220+770 and provision of PUP @ Ch:220+380 in the approach portion of Black spot (KA-02-186) under road safety for rectification of blackspots in the stretch of Mulbagal-AP/KNT Border Section of NH-75 (old No. NH-4) from Km.216+912 to Km.239+100 in the State of Karnataka under EPC mode - **Hosting of final outcome of Technical Evaluation of bids & Disposal of objections** - reg.

Sir,

The bids were received (online) for the subject work on 20.10.2021 till 15.00 Hrs. Bids were opened on 21.10.2021 at Regional Office, Bengaluru. The replies were sought from the non-responsive bidders by giving 07 days of time period to respond in case of any objection. The objections submitted by the bidders have been examined by the Evaluation Committee and final outcome is as detailed below;

With reference to our earlier report vide letter no. RIL/NHAI/2021-22/104 dated 15.12.2021, the Bidder was recommended as ineligible for opening of financial bid, due to non-fulfilment of minimum required net worth as per clause 2.2.2.3 (i) of RFP. The Bidder was requested to furnish the detailed workings regarding the assessment of claimed personal net worth of Rs. 26.87 Crore including the valuation reports of assets considered in personal net worth. The bidder in its reply, furnished Statutory Auditor certificate, certifying the net worth of Rs. 27.09 crore as on 31.03.2020. However, no documentary evidence with respect to claimed personal net worth of Rs. 26.87 crore was furnished by the bidder. Accordingly, the net worth of the bidder was assessed based on the balance sheet as on 31.03.2020. As per the submitted balance sheet, the net worth of the bidder was assessed as Rs. 22,17,696/- which was less than the required minimum net worth of Rs. 1.06 crore, thereby leading to disqualification pursuant to clause 2.2.2.3 (i) of RFP.

Subsequently, the result of technical evaluation was communicated to the bidder by the Authority, giving opportunity to respond within 7 days. The bidder in its representation has furnished the same Statutory Auditor Certificate as provided at the time of submission of bid, certifying the Net worth of Rs. 27.09 Crore as on 31.03.2020.

In view of the above, the Bidder's reply with respect to claimed Net worth is found to be unsatisfactory since no documentary evidence has been furnished in support of Personal Net worth of Rs. 26.87 crore. Thus, the assessment of bidder's Net worth as per our earlier report stands true and unchanged.

Therefore, the bidder stands disqualified for not meeting the requirement of clause 2.2.2.3 (i) of the RFP.

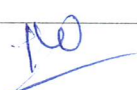
Note-2: M/s Arjunvaishnavi Infrastructure & Developers (P) Ltd.

With reference to our earlier report vide letter no. RIL/NHAI/2021-22/104 dated 15.12.2021, the Bidder was recommended as ineligible for opening of financial bid, since the claimed projects "A" to "E" were assessed as ineligible projects pursuant to clause 2.2.2.5 (iii) (II), thereby leading to disqualification as per clause 2.2.2.2(i) & 2.2.2.2(ii) of RFP.

Subsequently, the result of technical evaluation was communicated to the bidder by the Authority, giving opportunity to respond within 7 days. The bidder in its response has stated that projects "A" to "E" have been undertaken on EPC Basis. Upon review of the submitted client certificate and Statutory Auditor certificate pertaining to the claimed project, it is not ascertainable whether the claimed projects of periodic renewal have been undertaken on EPC basis, thereby rendering the project ineligible pursuant to clause 2.2.2.5 (iii) (II). The clause is reproduced hereunder as:

"Maintenance works are not considered as eligible project for evaluation as per Instruction No.6 to Annex-IV. As such works with nomenclature like PR, OR, FDR, SR, site/micro grading, surface renewal, resurfacing work, Tarring, B.T. surface work, temporary restoration, urgent works, periodic maintenance, repair & rehabilitation, one time maintenance, permanent protection work of bank, external prestressing, repair of central hinge, short term OMT contract of NHAI, any type of work related to border fencing, work of earthwork alone, construction of buildings/ hostels/hospitals, etc, or not specified, shall not be considered. However, such maintenance works shall be considered as eligible projects in case of maintenance works to be taken up on EPC mode."

Therefore, the bidder stands disqualified for not meeting the requirement of clause 2.2.2.2 (i) & 2.2.2.2 (ii) of the RFP.



Note-3: M/s RP Projects (P) Ltd.

With reference to our earlier report vide letter no. RIL/NHAI/2021-22/104 dated 15.12.2021, the Bidder was recommended as ineligible for opening of financial bid, due to non-fulfilment of minimum required technical capacity as per clause 2.2.2.2(i) of RFP. The bidder was requested to clarify as to why the claimed projects "B" & "C" should be considered as Eligible Project for the purpose of assessment of Technical Capacity. The bidder in its reply stated that the projects shall be considered under core sector (i.e. category-4) pursuant to clause 2.2.2.5 (iii) (b).

However, both the projects were assessed as ineligible, since the project pertains to "Manufacture, Supply, Fabrication and Erection of Chain link Fencing with MS angles, Barbed wire and providing basement with RR & Brick Masonry" and as such does not fall under the definition of core sector provided in clause 2.2.2.5 (iii) (b), leading to disqualification under clause 2.2.2.1 (i).

Subsequently, the result of technical evaluation was communicated to the bidder by the Authority, giving opportunity to respond within 07 days in case of objections if any. However, the bidder did not submit any reply/clarification and the period of 07 days have since elapsed. Thus, the Technical Capacity of the bidder has been assessed as Rs. 12.65 crore as against the minimum requirement of Rs. 15.96 Crore. Therefore, the bidder stands disqualified for not meeting minimum threshold technical capacity under clause 2.2.2.2 (i).

Note 4: M/s Sri Sathya Ganapathi Constructions

With reference to our earlier report vide letter no. RIL/NHAI/2021-22/104 dated 15.12.2021, the Bidder was recommended as ineligible for opening of financial bid, due to non-fulfilment of minimum required Bid Capacity as per clause 2.2.2.1. The bidder was requested to clarify as to why the Statutory auditor's certificates certifying the Value of A and the table containing value of all the existing commitments and on-going works (Value of B), does not bear UDIN. The bidder in its reply did not furnish the revised certificates bearing UDIN. In the absence of UDIN on Statutory Auditor certificate, the bid capacity of the bidder was assessed as nil, thereby leading to disqualification pursuant to clause 2.2.2.1.

Subsequently, the result of technical evaluation was communicated to the bidder by the Authority, giving opportunity to respond within 07 days in case of objections if any. However, the bidder did not submit any reply/clarification and the period of 07 days have since elapsed. Thus, the bid capacity of the bidder has been assessed as "NIL" thereby rendering the bidder disqualified for not meeting the requirement of clause 2.2.2.1 of RFP.

2. In view of the above, financial bids of the 06 Nos. of Technically responsive bidders (as mentioned in Table above) will be opened on **25.03.2022**.
