In case of delay in submission of Performance Security, if any, you may seek extension of time for a period not exceeding 60 (Sixty) days on payment of Damages in accordance with Clause 2.21 of RFP.
3. As per clause 2.21.2, the Performance Security shall be valid until 60 days after the defect liability period.
4. In case of failure of submission of Performance Security within the additional 60 (Sixty) days time period, the award shall be deemed to be cancelled by the Authority as per Clause 2.21 of the RFP.

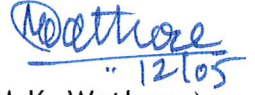

As per the recommendations of Bid Evaluation Committee vide Technical Minutes dated 22.04.2022, RO vide letter No.226 dated 22.04.2022, has accorded approval for opening of the Financial bids of 04 (four) technically responsive bidders. Accordingly the Bid Evaluation Committee has opened the Financial Bids on 25.04.2022.

In this context, the Financial proposals submitted by the bidders have been forwarded to financial consultants vide this office email dated 25.04.2022 and in response, financial consultants has submitted financial bid evaluation report for the subject project vide email dated 27.04.2022. The details of Financial proposals are as below:

As per Clause 3.3 of RFP, subject to the provisions of Clause 2.16.1 of RFP and in terms of Clause 3.1.6, the evaluation committee noted that **M/s. The Trinity Group.** has quoted the lowest price i.e. **Rs.26,57,00,000/-** excluding GST at 12% as per Appendix-IB (Letter comprising the Financial Bid) and therefore declares the said bidder as **"Selected Bidder"**.

Further, as per clause 2.10.1 of RFP, the selected bidder has submitted the following documents.

- (a) Original Power of Attorney for signing the BID as per format at Appendix-III;
- (b) Original Bid Securing Declaration in the format at Appendix-II; and
- (c) Integrity Pact (IP) duly signed by Authorised signatory;

As per Section-II vide clause 2.21.1 of RFP, the selected bidder shall furnish to the Authority an irrevocable and unconditional guarantee from a Bank in the form set forth in Appendix-VII (the "Performance Security") for an amount equal to **03% (three percent)** of its Bid Price i.e. **Rs.79,71,000/-** within 30 (thirty) days of receipt of Letter of Acceptance.

As per NHAI HQ Policy Circular No. 1.1.31/2019 dated 19.12.2019, Para 6.2, Regional Officer shall devise mitigation measures following provisions of para-5, approve the estimate, carry out necessary procurement and execute the works costing upto **Rs.50 Cr.** (including the cost of land acquisition) for each black spot including all centages, on COS/Standalone basis.

As per the above said NHAI Policy Circular, the Bid Evaluation Committee recommends for issue of LOA to the L1 bidder **M/s. The Trinity Group.** for the quoted amount of **Rs.26,57,00,000/-** excluding GST at 12% which is **below 14.01%** on the amount put to tender of **Rs.30,89,82,211/-** excluding GST at 12% and also recommends for obtaining the undertaking from the selected bidder for executing the subject work with the quoted amount as per the Conditions of Contract, by duly obtaining the approval of the Competent Authority.

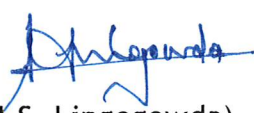

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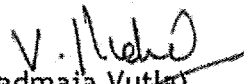
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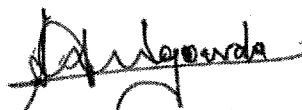
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
