Subject: In-Principle approval for Constitution of Committee for NIT and Tendering process

Project: "Construction of Convention Center at Aizawl, Mizoram under the Scheme of Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development"

The work of Construction of Convention Center at Aizawl, Mizoram under the Scheme of Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development of year 2020-21 with sanctioned amount of Rs. 39.94 Crore has been awarded to WAPCOS with PMC Charges of 8% exclusive of GST vide Ministry of Tourism ltr. no. 5(3)/20-IDD dtd. 31/03/2021 (Refer **Annex-1**).

Work will be awarded to Contractor by Open Tender procedure through Electronic Tendering System (ETS). The tender will be floated on WAPCOS website and www.etenders.gov.in/eprocure website of Government of India. The tender period will be 21 days.

It is proposed to constitute a Committee having representatives from Technical, Finance and Administrative wings who have digital signature. The committee will carry out the following activities as per established norms/standard guidelines/procedures.

1. Approval of Tender Document.
2. Calling of online bids
3. Technical and Financial Evaluation of bids
4. Selection of Contractor and award of works to the selected Contractor.

After approval of tender, tender will be uploaded on WAPCOS website and www.etenders.gov.in/eprocure website of Government of India. The Corrigendum, Addendum, Up gradation, etc. will be uploaded after approval of Competent Authority.

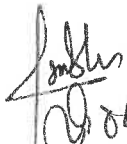
