The soft copy of Envelope I were opened at 1500 hours on 08/02/2022.

The following 04 bidders submitted bids.

1. M/s Botanis
2. M/s Durai Enterprises
3. Sh G. Chandramohan
4. M/s Kuppusamy & Co

The documents uploaded in e-portal envelope I are downloaded and presented as comparative statement.

As per comparative statement, M/s Botanis submitted only PAN card and did not submit any other documents like GST, EPF & ESI, Acceptance, Affidavit, Experience and annual turnover proof. Hence, M/s Botanis was requested to submit required documents through short fall document on or before 1600 hours on 09.02.2022.

The other three bidder M/s Durai Enterprises, Sh G. Chandramohan and M/s Kuppusamy & Co submitted all required documents as per NIT tech bid criteria and hence eligible for opening of financial bid.

The short fall document was opened on 1600 hours on 09.02.2022. The agency M/s Botanis submitted only PANCARD and failed to submit other required documents as per NIT tech bid criteria and hence not eligible for opening of financial bid.
