Airports Authority of India (AAI) hereinafter referred to as purchaser, is pleased to place purchase order for Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning and Maintenance of Critical Operations Power System (COPS) at Mopa Airport in favour of M/s. M/s. VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. , hereinafter referred as Contractor.

1. SCOPE OF WORK:

- 1.1 Supply, Installation, Testing, and Commissioning of Critical Operations Power System (COPS) using latest in design technology, integrated & equipped with all items / sub-systems/ sub-equipment /accessories, as specified in this document at listed sites, as per below listed minimum technical requirements/specifications.
- 1.2 Design, Manufacture, Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning of Critical Operations Power System (COPS), as per Terms & Conditions, basic operational performance, functional availability and reliability requirements specified herein for 365x24x7 Critical Operations of CNS Systems using latest in design technology of continuous duty, static, true online double conversion, IGBT based rectifier, Inverter & Converter, modular with N+1 redundancy, scalable architecture, three-phase input-output Uninterruptible Power System at 100% loading along with 03 years* Onsite Operational Performance Maintenance Warranty (OOPMW) inclusive of all spares, consumables including batteries & other accessories after successful SAT (Site Acceptance Testing) followed by 07 Years Onsite Operational Performance Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (OOPCAM) inclusive of all spares, components, consumables (excluding Batteries with 3 years warranty if supplied by AAI) & other accessories.

- 1.3 Replacement of Batteries after OOPWM, tender authority may take quote of SITC of Batteries on Buyback basis for first, Second & third replacement after 3 years, 6 years & 9 years after successful SAT. However tendering authority may decide to use the obtained quotes or procure separately.
- 1.4 Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning of CLASS B/Type I & CLASS C/Type II Surge Protection Devices (SPD), Isolation Transformer, Static Switch, PDU, Power Cables, and other accessories at the site as per Terms & Conditions, basic operational performance, functional availability and reliability requirements specified herein for 365x24x7 Critical Operations of CNS systems using latest in design technology with 03 years* Onsite Operational Performance Maintenance Warranty (OOPMW) inclusive of all spares, consumables & other accessories followed by 07 Years Onsite Operational Performance Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (OOPCAM) inclusive of all spares, components, consumables & other accessories. It must be ensured that battery temperature compensation mechanism is installed and fully functional and all the voltages/ terminators/ subcomponents/ subsystems are in proper place in UPS or Battery charger. Voltages must be set at the desired level compatible with the temperatures, as mentioned by manufacturer.
- 1.5 Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning of Central Monitoring System for COPS including Software, Server hardware, Switches, monitors, LAN infrastructure installed for COPS at the site as per Terms & Conditions, basic operational performance, functional availability and reliability requirements specified herein for 365x24x7 Critical Operations of CNS/ATM/Control & Monitoring Systems using latest in design technology with 03 years* Onsite Operational Performance Maintenance Warranty (OOPMW) inclusive of all spares, consumables & other accessories followed by 07 Years Onsite Operational Performance Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (OOPCAM) inclusive of all spares, components, consumables & other accessories.
- 1.6 Provide On Job ON-SITE OPERATIONAL TRAINING for AAI CNS personnel (minimum for 5 working days, in one batch of 08 trainees) shall be given at site.
- 1.7 Development, Implementation, Monitoring and Continuously Maintaining of Functional Performance Tests (FPTs) at all the sites during 03 years OOPMW inclusive of all spares, consumables including batteries & other accessories followed by 07 Years Onsite Operational Performance Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (OOPCAM) inclusive of all spares, components, consumables (excluding Batteries with 3 years warranty if supplied by AAI) & other accessories.
- 1.8 The Contractor shall carry out the following maintenance on their offered system in addition to manufacturers prescribed normal, preventive and corrective maintenance schedules during the OOPMW and OOPCAM period:
- 1.9 The Contractor shall maintain Preventive, Corrective, Break down visit record at site at AAI premise and get it counter signed by AAI representatives for monitoring of contract performance and applicability terms and condition of the contract.
- 1.10 Contractor shall visit AAI premises as many times as Breakdown calls are received and replace all the faulty & functionally not acceptable components/ parts/ LRU's/ functional systems/ displays/ monitors/ network switches/ servers and client workstations, batteries at its own cost.
- 1.11 Contractor shall visit AAI premises as many times as Breakdown calls are received and replace all the faulty & functionally not acceptable components/ parts/ LRU's/ functional systems/ displays/ monitors/ network switches/ servers and client workstations, batteries at its own cost.
- 1.12 Contractor shall utilize already laid power Cables, Input incomer panel & accessories and output

Panel/DBs & accessories installed at site. However any other accessories required at site to meet the requirements, the contractor shall include its cost and shall supply, install, test and commission the same within the quoted price.

1.13 Onsite Operational Performance Maintenance Warranty (OOPMW) and Onsite Operational Performance Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (OOPCAM) Contract Requirements:

- a) During 03 years Onsite Operational Performance Maintenance Warranty (OOPMW) and 07 years Onsite Operational Performance Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (OOPCAM) inclusive of all spares, consumables and other accessories, the contractor of UPS shall offer 365x7x24Hrs basis onsite service and maintenance / replacement/ spare support. The complaint shall be lodged by AAI through all types of Toll free Assistance i.e. by a telephone/mobile number/Email/Fax. Service Organization of the contractor firm shall attend the AAI raised complaint/issues within 24hours at the site from the lodging of a complaint regarding degradation /malfunctioning /non intended operations/ non optimum performance of a module/ subsystem/ system/set. All such complaints regarding equipment/system operations shall be resolved and restored by the service organization of the bidder firm within next 24 hrs. AAI shall maintain a fault log in respect of each such degradation, malfunctioning, non-optimum performance and restoration of a module/ subsystem/ system/set. All user replaceable spare parts/ LRU's of any of the OEM makes forming part of COPS UPS and accessories modules shall be available with the bidder's service organization 365 days a year. This service organization of contractor shall ship/ install/ replace/ test & restore parts/modules/ subsystem/ system to AAI site at any time during the day / night for restoring Operations in any of the site. AAI shall allow module level replacement but shall not allow any kind of component level repairs in UPS systems accessories at site. Failure to resolve functionality degradation issues of System at site within (24+24=)48 hrs shall result in deduction of 1% of Performance bank guarantee amount or from the running bill payable to the contractor as applicable, per Day subject to maximum of 10% per instance, by AAI. Such deductions shall be accounted to Performance Bank Guarantee submitted by Contractor as Security deposit to AAI for entire 03 years OOPMW and 05 years OOPCAM. Functionality degradation shall mean reduction/non-availability of Power in any COPS bus, failure or degradation in control, status monitoring, non-availability of redundancy in power modules etc...
- b) Contractor shall maintain sufficient inventory with its' service organization to ensure compliance of maintenance requirement of OOPMW and OOPCAM above.
- c) In case of any breakdown, the Contractors' service personnel shall fix the breakdown within 48Hrs from the time of the fault is logged. The system shall be handed over to AAI for operational use only after a successful FPT is completed.
- d) In OOPCAM period the contractor shall be responsible to install, test and commissioning the Batteries during all replacement's even if AAI procures and supply the equivalent Batteries with 3 years warranty if supplied by AAI for replacement.
- e) The Contractor shall ensure that the performance/FPT logs, UPS, batteries and all accessories are logged in System Administrator logs at all times and shall be available for reproduction using standard PC tools for a minimum of 30 calendar days.
- f) During FPT it must be ensured that battery temperature compensation mechanism is installed and fully functional and all the voltages/ terminators/ subcomponents/ subsystems are in proper place in UPS or Battery charger. Voltages must be set at the desired level compatible with the temperatures, as mentioned by manufacturer.
- g) Batteries temperature shall be maintained to such a value that it does not affect the life and performance of the battery i.e. the average temperature shall be maintained around the designed temperature indicated by manufacturer or typically at 25-40° Centigrade. Any variations must be brought out to the notice of AAI in writing.

- h) Battery charge/discharge/temperature shall be properly recorded indicating date, time, duration and discharge current, to present a fair idea about the health of the battery using appropriate interface and application software.
- i) Reasons for Frequent discharge or excessive cycles of discharge of batteries shall be tracked, avoided and presented to AAI for coordination and resolution, as this leads to grid corrosion and affects the life of Battery/performance. Each and every battery discharge shall be properly logged in the System Admin Logs.
- j) Contractor shall ensure that his service engineers do not allow the batteries to remain under charged and lose its functionality and shall always follow defined FPTs.
- k) Contractor shall ensure that his service engineers set the float and charge voltages of UPS or Battery charger as per battery manufacturer's instructions.
- l) Contractor shall ensure that his service engineers do not resort to fast charging by setting higher/Float/charge voltages.
- m) Contractor shall submit comprehensive performance report, on each visit to site, based on Preventive/Corrective maintenance; Performance logged in and his evaluation/analysis about UPS batteries and accessories to AAI representative at each site and obtain counter signature.
- n) Contractor can, if permitted by AAI, remote monitor the systems for its service efficacy. However Hardware /Software for remote operation / maintenance / monitoring, lines etc towards external world internet / link connectivity shall be charged to contractors account.
- o) Contractor must provide an OEM authorization to its service firm confirming the compliance and support by OEM for the entire period of OOPMW and OOPCAM with spares, components, consumables and other accessories & with related functional software & hardware technical specifications for System equipment and terms and conditions. However ultimate responsibility shall be with Contractor account only.
- p) For evaluation of the offered documentation, one set of "Operations", "Technical and Maintenance" manual shall be submitted by the Contractor as part of technical bid. The Training manual shall be submitted well before training for AAI Approval. Contents of Technical & Training and all documents shall be presented to AAI in English Language only. The UPS shall also be designed in accordance to recommendations of following organizations and committees.

 - 1.2. IEEE 519-1992 Standard Practices and Requirements for Harmonic Control in Electrical Power Systems.

5. **PRICE:**

M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. will supply, Install, Test, commission and maintain Critical Operations Power Systems (COPS) at Mopa Airport as per AAI tender document, at a total cost of Rs. 3,45,03,624.00 plus GST Inclusive of Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning, 03 Years Onsite Operational Performance Maintenance Warranty (OOPMW) inclusive of all spares, consumables including batteries & other accessories after successful SAT (Site Acceptance Testing) followed by 07 Years Onsite Operational Performance Comprehensive Annual Maintenance (OOPCAM) inclusive of all spares, components, consumables & other accessories.

5.1 **PAYMENT TERMS:**

- 5.1.1 No mobilization advance shall be paid.
- 5.1.2 70% of purchase order price for supply of items against receipt of goods at site in good condition
- 5.1.3 Balance 30 % of goods cost and 100% of Installation and commissioning cost on completion of Installations and site acceptance by AAI.
- 5.1.4 Payment shall be released to the Contractor on submission of following documents:
- 5.1.5 Invoice + 2 copies
- 5.1.6 Itemized Packing list + 2 copies
- 5.1.7 Proof of dispatch of items – factory gate pass etc.
- 5.1.8 Installation / commissioning Certificate duly attested by AAI's representative.
- 5.1.9 3% of total amount will be retained **as Security Deposit** in the event of failure in submitting performance bank guarantee within stipulated time. However same will be released after submission of performance bank guarantee.

6.0 **Warranty/Guarantee:**

Minimum 36 Months warranty /guarantee shall be provided on the entire project and the actual warranty/guarantee period will start from the date of commissioning.

All goods or material shall be supplied strictly in accordance with the specifications. No deviation from such specifications of these conditions shall be made without AAI's agreement in writing must be obtained before any work against the order is commenced. All materials furnished by the M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. pursuant to the Order (irrespective of whether engineering/design or other information has been furnished, reviewed or approved by AAI) are required to be guaranteed to be of the best quality of their respective kinds (unless otherwise specifically authorized in writing by AAI) and shall be free from faulty design to the extent such design is not furnished by AAI. The goods/material used by M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. and its workmanship should be of proper quality so as to fulfil in all respects, the operating conditions and other requirements specified in the order.

If any trouble or defect originating from the design, materials, workmanship or operating characteristic of any materials arise **during warranty period** bidder is notified thereof, the bidder at his own expense (including manpower, freight, duty and customs for items sent for repair) and at no cost to AAI, as promptly as possible make such alterations, repairs and replacement at the site as may be necessary to permit facilitate the functioning of the equipment in accordance with the specifications. The warranty period of repaired or replaced goods shall be extended for a period equal to the turnaround time (out of service period).

In the event that the materials supplied do not meet the specifications and/ or are not in accordance with the drawings and datasheets and rectification as required at the site. AAI shall inform the bidder giving full details of deficiencies. The bidder shall at his own expense, meet and agree with the representatives of AAI the action required to correct the deficiencies and shall attend to the deficiencies at his own expense. Replacement under warranty clause shall be made by the supplier free of all charges at site including freight, insurance and other incidental charges.

M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. shall repair the unserviceable items failed during the warranty period within turnaround time of 10 days (for Indian suppliers). Turn around period is defined as the time period between the unserviceable item received by the supplier in factory and time when serviceable item is dispatched from the factory. Any delay in repairing the unserviceable card shall attract Liquidated Damage (LD) which shall be deducted either from the performance Bank Guarantee or from Security Deposit.

AAI reserves the right to en-cash complete value of performance Bank guarantee or forfeit security deposit, if the performance of supplied items is not satisfactorily without assigning any reason.

There will be no warranty of the cables, conduits used in the system. Contractor will not be liable for any damage to equipment's arising out of war, riots and natural calamity such as fire, storm earth quake etc. during warranty period.

7.0 DISPATCH OF DOCUMENTS:

M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. shall forward two sets of the following documents, one each to the General Manager (CNS-WR) AAI, Mumbai and the Port consignee as soon as goods are dispatched

- a) Invoice + 2 copies
- b) Itemized Packing list with cost of each item + 2 copies
- c) Proof of dispatch of items
- d) Receipt from the Consignee for completion of S.I.T.C.

8 TESTING AND INSPECTION:

8.1 FACTORY ACCEPTANCE TEST (FAT): For UPS & ISOLATION TRANSFORMER

- 8.2 Factory inspection of complete system shall be made by Authorized representative of AAI. Their travel, boarding and lodging expenses will be borne by AAI.
- 8.3 The bidder shall give 7 days' written notice of readiness of the system for the purpose of factory acceptance test. Such test shall be to the Bidder's account. Factory Acceptance Test documents shall be comprehensive and list all the procedures that shall be used to satisfy Authorized representative of AAI on specifications test results. Factory Acceptance documents submitted by bidder shall be approved by AAI before Tests. The bidder shall propose the number of days for the FAT based on tests required to be demonstrated. During the FAT necessary documents as defined in the Section-C need to be provided to the AAI inspection team.
- 8.4 The completion of these tests or issue of certificate by the Authorized representative of AAI shall not bind AAI to accept the equipment. Should the equipment, after installation and use, be found not complying with the specifications stipulated in the contract.
- 8.5 AAI will communicate in writing to the supplier, in case it does not depute the official(s) for Factory Acceptance Tests and in such case the inspection certificate, issued by the Quality Control Department of the manufacturer will be considered for acceptance of equipment by AAI.
- 8.6 The certificate issued by the Quality Control Department, complete with all test results as contained in the FAT Document shall be sent to GM (CNS-WR), AAI, Integrated Operational Office Building, New Airport colony, Vile Parle East, Mumbai immediately after receiving the advice from AAI that no Authorized representative of AAI is being deputed for FAT.
- 8.7 If any deficiency is pointed out by AAI within 10 working days from the date of completion of inspection or receipt of QCD report, then the bidder shall give due consideration to such objections and shall carry out repairs/alterations that may be necessary to correct the said objections and arrange for the supplementary QCD or FAT giving 10 days' notice to AAI (for which the to and fro travel expenses and boarding and lodging expenses are to be borne by the

bidder). After, the Supplementary FAT has been completed at bidder's works; the Authorized representative of AAI shall issue a certificate to this effect as soon as possible, but not exceeding 10 working days after completion of the tests.

- 8.8 Even after supplementary Quality Control Department or supplementary FAT, if the equipment is found not in conformance to tender technical requirements **Annexure-XI** of this tender, then AAI shall cancel the contract.
- 8.9 Equipment shall be dispatched by bidder only on specific dispatch confirmation/advice from AAI. Acceptance of FAT/QCD certificate and advice for dispatch of equipment shall be issued by AAI within 7 days of the receipt of the FAT/QCD certificate. If no advice is received from AAI within 7 days of receipt of certificate by them, the FAT/QCD certificate may be deemed accepted and equipment may be dispatched.

9 SITE ADAPTATION, SITE ACCEPTANCE TEST (SAT) & COMMISSIONING:

- 9.1 It will be the responsibility of the vendor / bidder to submit the system test procedure for conducting the post installation site acceptance testing. The procedure submitted by the vendor should be drafted in line with the standard practices followed in the industry and should be in accordance with the test procedures & practices specified by the OEM. The acceptance test procedure on approval by AAI shall become the document for acceptance of the equipment after installation at the site. The draft copy of system test procedure should be made available to AAI for approval before 7 days of the schedule site acceptance date.
- 9.2 The system will be commissioned after successful completion of approved SAT, operational & maintenance training and all the works under the scope of the tender.
- 9.3 Installation will be termed as completed after successful completion of SAT.

10. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG):

- 10.1 M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. shall furnish the Contract Performance Bank Guarantee as specified in the tender within 30 days of issue of purchase/work order and it should remain valid for a period of 90 (ninety) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier, including warranty obligations.. The value of Performance Bank Guarantee shall be @3 % of the total project cost for contract period from the issue of purchase order. This has to be done in a fixed period of time as per terms and conditions of the tender to avoid any delay in execution of work. In case of delay in execution of work the bidder shall be required to proportionately extend the PBG. In case M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. fails to submit the PBG within stipulated period, interest @ 12% p.a. on Performance Guarantee amount would be levied (non-refundable) for delayed period of submission and shall be deducted from EMD or First running Bill. In case M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. fails to submit Performance Bank Guarantee within 60 days of issue of purchase/work order, AAI reserves the right to forfeit EMD and cancel the order.

- 10.2 The Performance Guarantee amount shall be payable to AAI without any condition whatsoever and the guarantee shall be irrevocable.
- 10.3 The Performance Guarantee shall be deemed to govern the following guarantees from M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. in addition to other provisions of the guarantee:
- 10.4 The Hardware/Software supplied under the contract shall be free from all defects/bugs and upon written notice from AAI, M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. shall fully remedy, free of expenses to AAI, all such defects/bug as developed under the normal use of the said hardware/software within the period of guarantee/Warranty.
- 10.5 The Performance Guarantee is intended to secure the performance of the entire system. However, it is not to be construed as limiting the damages stipulated in any other clause.
- 10.6 The Performance Guarantee will be returned to M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. at the end of the period of liability without interest.
- 10.7 M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. will be fully responsible for the guaranteed performance of the supplied systems under warranty period. In case of any problem after commissioning and during guarantee warranty period M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. will depute required resources to AAI's site to remove all defects at contractor's cost.
- 10.8 The acceptance of valid reasons for non-compliance to clause 4 above shall attracts a fine at the whole discretion of AAI (subject to maximum 10% of the Contract Value) and AAI's decision with regard to imposition of the fine shall be final. The fine shall be recovered from the Performance Bank Guarantee.
- 10.9 PBG shall be refunded to M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. without interest, after he duly performs and completes the contract in all respects but not later than 90 (ninety) days of completion of all such obligations including the warranty under the contract.
- 10.10 M/s.VITS Total Power Solutions Pvt. Ltd. shall submit BG (PBG/BG-SD/FBG) in accordance with the bank details.

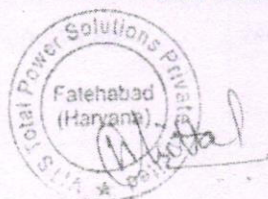
