

**Recommendation of TEC on Evaluation of Technical Bids for "Online
tender for Procurement of Survey Equipment
SCHEDULE 'A' (Single Beam Echo Sounder with Transducer)
SCHEDULE 'B' (Heading DGPS cum Beacon Receiver for survey and
Navigation) and SCHEDULE 'C' (DGPS Receiver)
(after clarifications 2)**

Online bids were called by IWAI by publishing NIT in leading newspapers, uploading of NIT and Tender document on IWAI website and CPP Portal for "Procurement of Survey Equipment SCHEDULE 'A' (Single Beam Echo Sounder with Transducer)"_SCHEDULE 'B' (Heading DGPS cum Beacon Receiver for survey and Navigation) and SCHEDULE 'C' (DGPS Receiver). In response to the NIT, 2 nos. bidder have submitted their online bids before the stipulated last date, 16.02.2022 at 1500 hrs. The details of the bidders who submitted their bids are as follows: -

- (i) M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., 105, Phase IV, Udyog Vihar, Gurgaon-122015
 - (ii) M/s Aditi Infotech, B-3, First Floor, Swapnil Apartment, Abhyankar Road, Dhantoli, Nagpur- 440012
2. The duly constituted Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) comprising of the following officers have opened the online technical bids on 17.02.2022 at 1500 hrs.:
- (i) Shri P. Srinivasa, Dir. (Hy)
 - (ii) Shri Rajiv Singhal, S.H.S.
 - (iii) Shri Kishan Chand, Sr. A.O.
3. Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) met on 25.02.2022 and examined the technical bids with respect to the terms and conditions and Technical & Special conditions stipulated in the tender document. Based on the evaluation, the TEC observed that both the bidders had not furnished some of the required information as specified in the tender conditions and recommended to ask to furnish necessary short fall documents.
4. With due approval of the Competent Authority, vide letter dated 25.02.2022 and CPP Portal, both the bidders were requested to furnish the same by 04.03.2022 at 1400 hours.
5. Both the bidders have submitted clarifications in time.
6. After receiving clarification from the bidders, Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) met on 08.03.2022 and examined the technical bids with respect to the terms and conditions and Technical & Special conditions stipulated in the tender document. Based on the evaluation, the TEC observed that **the bidder M/s Aditi Infotech, Nagpur has not submitted Bank Solvency, Authorization certificate as Supplier and other documents, the firm is found to be non-responsive and**

technically dis-qualified. Further, TEC observed M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram has not submitted completion certificate as per Clause 10.1.3 (e) of ITB in respect of Schedule 'B' and 'C' and recommended to ask to furnish necessary short fall documents.

7. With due approval of the Competent Authority, vide letter dated 08.03.2022 and CPP Portal, **M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram** was requested to furnish the same by 10.03.2022 at 1400 hours.
8. **M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram** has submitted the shortfall documents on 09.03.2022.
9. After receiving clarification from the bidder, Tender Evaluation Committee (TEC) met on 10.03.2022 and examined the submitted shortfall documents. A Comparative statement is prepared after evaluating the clarifications and the same placed at Annex-1 and 3.
10. The observations and recommendations of TEC after evaluating the Clarification are as follows:

I. For Schedule "A"

(i) M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram:

Firm has submitted all the requisite documents as per T&C of tender documents for Schedule "A".

Hence, the bidder is technically qualified.

(ii) M/s Aditi Infotech, Nagpur: Firm has not submitted following documents:

1. Bank Solvency certificate as per Clause - 10.1.1 (d) of ITB.
2. Board Resolution, details of top management (Board members), key officials with documentary evidence, Articles of Association/ Memorandum of Association of the Company as per Clause 10.1.2 (e) of ITB.
3. Documentary evidence such as manufacturer valid registration certificate for manufacturing of Authorization certificate as Dealer/ Supplier and Service Provider of reputed brand of the equipment(s) for which the bidder intended to quote as per Clause 10.1.3 (a) of ITB.
4. Annual turnover of 2019-20 as per Clause 10.1.2 (h) of ITB.
5. Completion Certificate clearly mentioning the contract values as per tender clause 10.1.3 (e) of ITB.

As the bidder has not submitted Bank Solvency, Authorization certificate as Supplier and other documents, the firm is found to be non-responsive and technically dis-qualified.

II. For Schedule "B"

(i) **M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram:**

Firm has submitted all the requisite documents as per T&C of tender documents for Schedule "A".

Hence, the bidder is technically qualified.

(ii) **M/s Aditi Infotech, Nagpur** Firm has not submitted following documents:

1. Bank Solvency certificate as per Clause - 10.1.1 (d) of ITB.
2. Board Resolution, details of top management (Board members), key officials with documentary evidence, Articles of Association/ Memorandum of Association of the Company as per Clause 10.1.2 (e) of ITB.
3. Documentary evidence such as manufacturer valid registration certificate for manufacturing of Authorization certificate as Dealer/ Supplier and Service Provider of reputed brand of the equipment(s) for which the bidder intended to quote as per Clause 10.1.3 (a) of ITB.
4. Annual turnover of 2019-20 as per Clause 10.1.2 (h) of ITB.
5. Completion Certificate clearly mentioning the contract values as per tender clause 10.1.3 (e) of ITB.

As the bidder has not submitted Bank Solvency, Authorization certificate as Supplier and other documents, the firm is found to be non-responsive and technically dis-qualified.

III. For Schedule "C"

(i) **M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram:**

Firm has submitted all the requisite documents as per T&C of tender documents for Schedule "A".

Hence, the bidder is technically qualified.

(ii) **M/s Aditi Infotech, Nagpur** Firm has not submitted following documents:

1. Bank Solvency certificate as per Clause - 10.1.1 (d) of ITB.
2. Board Resolution, details of top management (Board members), key officials with documentary evidence, Articles of Association/ Memorandum of Association of the Company as per Clause 10.1.2 (e) of ITB.
3. Documentary evidence such as manufacturer valid registration certificate for manufacturing of Authorization certificate as Dealer/ Supplier and Service Provider of reputed brand of the equipment(s) for which the bidder intended to quote as per Clause 10.1.3 (a) of ITB.
4. Annual turnover of 2019-20 as per Clause 10.1.2 (h) of ITB.
5. Completion Certificate clearly mentioning the contract values as per tender clause 10.1.3 (e) of ITB.

As the bidder has not submitted Bank Solvency, Authorization certificate as Supplier and other documents, the firm is found to be non-responsive and technically dis-qualified.

TEC Observations: It was brought to the notice of the Committee that this tender was earlier floated during October, 2021 and online technical bid was opened on 16.11.2021. M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram was only the single bidder and it was recommended to re-tender without asking clarifications. TEC further observed that wide publicity was given, yet only one valid bid has been received for the items. These Hydrographic Survey equipment are very specialized system which are used by mariners for precise navigation. These requires expertise, after sale support and financial capability and hence availability of such firms is very limited in India.

In view of the above and to save NIT expenses and time & cost overrun, the **TEC recommends to technically qualify the single bidder, i.e. M/s Pan India Consultants Pvt. Ltd., Gurgaon for Schedule 'A', 'B' and 'C' and to open their financial bid.**
