

9. DISCUSSION AND RECOMMENDATIONS OF TEC

On the basis of above detailed deliberations, the Tender evaluation committee makes its recommendations as under.

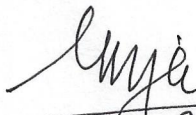
- i. The Technical proposal of the only tenderer M/s. Sai Projects (Mumbai) Private Ltd. is substantially responsive and satisfying the EQC requirements as prescribed in the tender document. Hence, their financial proposals may be opened.
- ii. In Letter of Tender- Technical part, the tenderer has not selected options against para "h" and "m" of the letter (Page- 515 & 516 of Offer-1 File). Clarifications may be obtained from the tenderer before finalization of tender.
- iii. Form FIN 3.3.5 is not submitted by the tenderer with their offer. Since, only one tenderer has participated, applicability of Domestic preference does not arise and it will not make any change in inter-se- position. This may be obtained before finalization of tender.
- iv. Environment, Health & Safety Expert require as per tender condition shall have academic qualification of Graduate Engineering with specialization and/or additional qualification in relevant filed. EHS Expert proposed by the tenderer is only B.E. (Civil), i.e. does not have specialization and/or additional qualification in relevant filed. Clarification or undertaking may be obtained from the tenderer for deployment of Expert as per tender condition before finalization of tender.

Acceptance/rejection/modification of these TEC recommendations lies in the competence of ED/Civil, MRVC as per Item No. 2.01(a) & 3.01 of SOP of July 2022 on Works Matter.
