

Minutes of Financial bid opening held on 03.06.2022 at Regional Office, Chennai.

4. The Comparative Statement of the Financial Bids quoted by the bidders and their position with respect to the estimate amount is enclosed as Annexure-I.

5. It is observed by the Tender Evaluation Committee that the lowest quoted bid of M/s. PM Infra, Namakkal for Rs.17,61,79,360 is at 18.92% less than the estimated cost. Therefore, Tender Evaluation Committee has decided that the work may be awarded to the lowest bidder on receipt of Bank Guarantee for an amount of Rs.52,85,381/- towards Performance security and Bank Guarantee for Rs. 38,78,128/- towards Additional Performance security as per Section 2.21.1, Part-I of RFP.

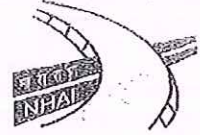

NHA/Policy Guidelines/Contract Administration/2022

Policy Circular No. 9.2.35/2022 dated 10th May, 2022

{Decision taken on E-Office File No. NHA/CMD/EPC/2020 (Computer No: 46753)}

Sub.: Identification of Abnormally Low Bid and seeking of Additional Performance Security/ Bank Guarantee (BG) in case of Abnormally Low Bids for EPC Projects- Reg.

Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure vide its OM No. F.9/4/2020-PPD dated 12.11.2020 reiterated that no provisions should be kept in the Bid Documents regarding Additional Security Deposit/Bank Guarantee (BG) in case of Abnormally Low Bids (ALBs). It has been further mentioned that wherever, there are compelling circumstances to ask for Additional Security Deposit/ BG in case of ALBs, the same should be taken only with the approval of the next higher authority to the authority competent to finalise the particular tender, or the Secretary of the Ministry/Department, whichever is lower. Further, these instructions are applicable for all kinds of procurements viz. Goods, Consultancy, Works, non-consulting Services etc. These guidelines were circulated by Ministry of Road Transport and Highways vide OM No. F.No. G-20016/01/2020-TF-II dated 17.11.2020 and further circulated by NHA for implementation vide Policy circular no. 3.1.27 dated 19.11.2020.

2. NHA vide Policy Circular No. 3.1.30/2021 dated 20.01.2021 decided that provision of Additional BG for ALBs be continued but with maximum ceiling of value of such BG up to value of Performance Security BG. However, it was decided vide NHA Policy Circular No. 15.10/2021 dated 02.07.2021 not to take Additional BG for ALBs (except in some exceptional cases).

3. The difficulties were being faced in identification of the exceptional cases for considering a particular bid as an ALB and thus deciding about the compelling circumstances to ask for Additional Security/ BG for the same. To address this issue, now, it has been decided to identify the ALBs as under:

3.1 When Responsive Bids received are more than single bid:

- (i) First Average Bid Price of maximum five nos. of lowest bids may be worked out.
- (ii) In case, this average bid price is less than the Authority's Estimated Project Cost (EPC) put to tender, the Bid Price quoted by the lowest bidder (L1) is to be compared with the Average Bid Price and if the Bid Price quoted by L1 is lower by more than 10% from the average Bid Price, then the bid quoted by L1 shall be considered as an ALB.
- (iii) In case, the average bid price is more than the Authority's Estimated Project Cost (EPC) put to tender, the Bid Price quoted by the lowest bidder (L1) is to be compared with the EPC and if the Bid Price quoted by L1 is lower by more than 10% from EPC, then the bid quoted by L1 shall be considered as an ALB.

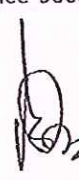
3.2 When only single responsive bid is received:

If the single bid received is found lower by more than 10% of Authority's EPC then the same shall be considered as an ALB.

4. Computation of amount of Additional Performance Security: If the Bid quoted by L1 has been identified as an ALB, then the amount of Additional Performance Security shall be computed as per clause 2.21.1 of RFP as under:

- (a) If the Bid price offered by the Selected Bidder is lower than 10% but upto 20% of the estimated project cost, then the Additional Performance Security shall be calculated @ 20% of the difference in the (i) Estimated Project Cost (as mentioned in RFP) - 10% of the Estimated Project Cost and (ii) the Bid Price offered by the selected Bidder but with maximum ceiling of value of such Additional Performance Security up to value of Performance Security BG.
- (b) If the Bid price offered by the Selected Bidder is lower than 20% of the estimated project cost, then the Additional Performance Security shall be calculated @ 30% of the difference in the (i) Estimated Project Cost (as mentioned in RFP) - 10% of the Estimated Project Cost and (ii) the Bid Price offered by the selected Bidder but with maximum ceiling of value of such Additional Performance Security up to value of Performance Security BG.
