Sub : Short Term Improvement and Routine Maintenance for the work of Four laning of Chhapra-Hajipur section except 2 laning of Chhapra Bypass of NH-19 from Km.143.200 to Km,209.40 in the state of Bihar under NHDP phase III on BOT(Annuity) on DBFOT basis

With reference to NIT No. 143/RO-PATNA/NHAI/2022-23, two firms (i) M/s R. K Jain Infra Projects Pvt. Ltd & (ii) M/s Vinay Construction have submitted the tender online through e- tendering portal for the above mentioned work and following status has been found after technical evaluation by tender committee:-

Sl. No.	Name of Bidders	Status (Qualified / Disqualified)	Reason for Disqualification
1.	M/s R. K Jain Infra Projects Pvt. Ltd	Disqualified	Bidder has not attached the existing Commitment i.e. "B" in the format of RFP. Hence, after calculation, the Bid Capacity comes out as less than required. Therefore, as per clause 4.6 of RFP, the instant bidder has been treated as technically disqualified.
2.	M/s Vinay Construction	Disqualified	➤ The experience certificate attached by the bidder is of the less amount and also not as per the required laning configuration. Hence, as per clause 4.4 A (b), the instant bidder has been treated as technically disqualified. ➤ Bidder has attached the audited turn over certificate from the two CAs at page no. 14 & 15. However, the amount is not matching with each other over the Financial year. ➤ As the turn over certificate attached by the bidder is not proper and existing commitment i.e. "B" is not as per the format of RFP, Bid Capacity can't be checked at this point. Hence, the bid of instant bidder has been treated as technically disqualified as per clause 4.6 of RFP.

Therefore, the instant tender has been cancelled and fresh bid may be invited.
