2. The financial bids of technically responsive bidders will be opened on 21.03.2022 at 1100 hrs IST after ascertaining bid capacity status updated as on the day before opening the financial bids.

3. The above mentioned technically responsive are requested to provide the bid capacity status updated as on the day before opening the financial bids, as per Cl. 2.2.2.1 of RFP by 20.03.2023 (1100 IST), failing which appropriate action may be taken as per RFP. It may be noted that the works for which bidder has emerged as the winner of the bids but LOA has not been issued as on the day before opening the financial bids along with other awarded/ ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of the works for which BID is invited shall also be considered while calculating value of B (value of existing commitments).

Note: 1: ALLONE Infra Private Limited:

The Bidder is declared not eligible/responsive for next stage of Bidding as per Clause 2.2.2.2(ii) of RFP. Refer detail below:

- In case of Project code 'b', namely, "Balance work of construction of Widening, Strengthening In the state of Jharkhand", the Bidder has submitted the performance certificate from its Client, however, as per said certificate, the JV members (i.e. MGCPL SCC (JV)) has executed work amounting to Rs. 245.40 Crore out of Rs. 272.00 Crore, i.e. 90.22% of the work has been completed as on the date of issuance of certificate i.e. 21.10.2022. However, it is not clear whether more than 90% of Value of work was completed as on 31.03.2022 or not.
- Further, the project is awarded to JV members and the share of allone Infra Private Limited (formerly known as SCC) is not mentioned/ reflected in the performance certificate.

Therefore, in view of the above and as per project claimed in Annex-II & Annex-IV, the Bidder is not meeting the minimum eligibility criteria as specified in Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of RFP, i.e. one similar work of **20% of Estimated Project Cost i.e. Rs. 81.06 crore** shall have been completed or substantially completed (i.e. where more than 90% value of work have been completed) over the last 5 Financial Years i.e. up to 31-03-2022 from the Eligible Projects in Category 1 and/or Category 3 specified in Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of RFP read in conjunction with Clause 2.2.2.2(i) of RFP, wherein it has been specifically mentioned that the last 5 (five) years preceding the Bid Due Date are to be considered.

Note: 2: Eaglecon Heavy Works:

The Bidder is declared as Non- Responsive. Refer detail below:

The Bidder has not submitted the proof of online payment of document fees. Also, the Bidder has not submitted any documents such as Appendix-IA including Annexure-I to VI, Appendix-II, Appendix-III, Appendix-VI, Appendix-VII, etc. and other Technical Bids.

Therefore, in the absence of submission of its Technical Bid, the Bidder is declared as Non-Responsive.

Note: 3: Amar Infrastructure Ltd.- PS Constructions JV:

The Bidder is declared as conditionally - qualified for next stage of Bidding. Refer detail below:

- In 1st para 10th line, the words "(and acting on behalf of its JV) has been omitted. Bidder is required to submit an amendment to Bank Guarantee duly mentioning the omitted words.

Therefore, the bidder is required to submit the same before for next stage of bidding process i.e. updated bid capacity.

Note 4: Ram Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd.:

The Bidder is declared as conditionally - qualified for next stage of Bidding. Refer detail below:

- In 2nd line of Para 14, the address of Haryana Branch is mentioned instead of New Delhi Branch. Bidder is required to submit an amendment to Bank Guarantee duly mentioning the address of New Delhi Branch.

Therefore, the bidder is required to submit the same before for next stage of bidding process i.e. updated bid capacity.
