This has reference to bids invited for subject work. In this regard, it is to inform that based on the bids and subsequent representations received, the Technical Evaluation has been completed. In compliance to clause 5.4 of Section-1 of RFP and final evaluation as per updated technical capacity details provided by the bidders, the shortlisted top 5 (five) bidders are as under:

(ii)	M/s Marc Technocrats Private Limited in JV with M/s Bloom Companies LLC in association with M/s SHREYA INFRA CONSULTANTS PRIVATE LIMITED	As per the result uploaded vide NHAI letter dated 13.10.2023, the detailed calculation of Technical Capacity was also displayed to all the bidders. In the calculations of technical capacity for M/s Marc Technocrats Private Limited in JV with M/s Bloom Companies LLC in association with M/s SHREYA INFRA CONSULTANTS PRIVATE LIMITED, the average annual in last three financial year was taken as Rs. 21.45 Crores & Rs. 102.63 Crores respectively for Lead Partner & JV Partner (submitted by bidder as on bid due date) and no. of permanent Key personnel on full time roll were considered as 32 for Lead Partner (M/s Marc) & 30 JV Partner (M/s Bloom). The bidder did not object/submit anything in this regard at the time of submission of representation/clarifications. However, the bidder now at the time of submitting updated technical capacity details has submitted more documents i.e. Form 26 AS in support of balance 11 nos. of key personnel mentioned in the bid. Although the submitted documents are for key personnel already mentioned in the bid, however considering such documents at this stage would entail revision in manpower for calculation of updated technical capacity. In this regard, NHAI vide Policy Circular no. 10.1.37 dated 10.11.2023 has specifically clarified that <i>"The works awarded on the date of opening of financial bid and in progress will be taken into consideration for ascertaining the balance capacity. The revised turnover/manpower will not be considered and would remain same as per Bid Due Date"</i> Hence, the revised manpower has not be considered and the updated technical capacity is calculated as per details available in the bid as on Bid Due Date. Accordingly, bidder falls under category 2 accordingly maximum 09 no. of IE/AE/SC projects is permitted. Further as per the submission of bidder in Updated Technical capacity details, JV bidder has 9.18 nos. of IE/AE/SC ongoing assignments which exceeds the limit of 9, therefore the bidder is declared In-Eligible on account of updated bid capacity as on date, as per RFP Clause 15 (C)(3).
(iii)	M/s Theme Engineering Services Private Limited in association with M/s Ishita Info Solutions Private Limited	Not eligible, as the bidder has changed JV share in one project from 40% as was submitted in the bid as compared to 70% submitted in updated bid capacity. As per Clause 15 (C)-(v) of section 1 of RFP - For the purpose of calculation of maximum no. of projects, the works awarded on the date of opening of Financial Bid and in progress will be taken into consideration as utilized capacity. The Consultant shall provide these details and they shall be solely responsible for accuracy of such details provided. However, in case of M/S Theme Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd in JV with Geo Designs And Research Pvt. Ltd in its submission has provided different JV share in revised technical capacity in comparison to as submitted in the bids for the project mentioned under sr. no. 7 and As per Clause 1.7-(c) of Section 2 of RFP, a firm shall be ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in

		competing for, or in executing, a contract, the same has been decided in Executive committee meeting no. 594 dated 15.12.2023.
(iv)	M/s L N Malviya Infra Projects Pvt. Ltd. in association with M/s Intratech civil Solution & Consultant	Not Eligible as technical capacity exhausted.
