Further, as per clause 2.21.3 of RFP, the Selected Bidder has the option to provide 50% of the Performance Security and additional performance security within 30 (thirty) days of receipt of Letter of Acceptance and the remaining Performance Security and additional performance security shall be submitted within 30 days of signing of the contract agreement.

It may further be noted that, as per clause 2.11.2 of the RFP, the Lowest Bidder is required to submit the original of the following documents physically before issuance of Letter of Acceptance (LOA) by the Authority:

1. Power of Attorney for signing of Bid,
2. Integrity Pact
3. Bid Security
4. Undertaking from the person having PoA referred in sub-clause (a) of Clause 2.11.2 that they agree and abide by the Bid documents uploaded by NHAI and amendments uploaded, if any
5. Certificate regarding Compliance with Restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs)
6. Copy of Registration from the Competent Authority as defined in Public Procurement Order No. F. No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July 2020, if applicable (to be submitted by the "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India").

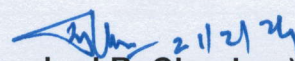
- 2.0 In light of the above, **Shri Sai Construction Company** is found to be **selected Bidder/ L1 Bidder**.
- 3.0 In view of the above, this Committee concurred the recommendations of the Financial Consultant and recommends that the subjected work may be awarded to the Selected Bidder/L1 Bidder, **Shri Sai Construction Company**, with a quoted offer of **Rs.74,99,99,999/-** [Rupees Seventy four crore ninety nine lakh ninety nine thousand nine hundred and ninety nine only] i.e. 21.46% below the estimated cost of Rs.95,49,00,000/-.
- 4.0 Before issuance of the LOA, the original documents as per Clause-2.11.2 of RFP Document may be obtained from the selected Bidder.

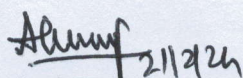

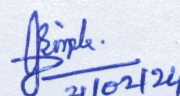
