

From the above comparative statement, it is observed that out of 11 (eleven) bidders, 5(five) bidders are to be technically qualified i.e (2/11) M/s Rynaa Construction, (3/11) M/s Kishore Bora, (4/11) M/s Gravel, (8/11) M/s Ranu Nandi & (9/11) M/s Amar Bora as they have submitted all the requisite documents to fulfill all technical parameters as mentioned in the tender document and other 6(six) bidders ie. (1/11) M/s G.J.P Enterprises, (5/11) M/s Dipankar Bhattacharjee, (6/11) M/s B.K Associates, (7/11) M/s Shivam House of Enterprise, (10/11) M/s Rama Shankar Prasad & (11/11) M/s Mr. Subrata Dey have not submitted all the requisite documents to fulfill all technical parameters as mentioned in the tender document and TEC considered them to be technically disqualified bidder. Finally, TEC recommends to (2/11) M/s Rynaa Construction, (3/11) M/s Kishore Bora, (4/11) M/s Gravel, (8/11) M/s Ranu Nandi & (9/11) M/s Amar Bora are technically qualified bidders as they have submitted all the required documents to fulfil all the technical parameters mentioned in the tender documents. Further, TEC recommends to open the financial bid of the above technically qualified bidders i.e. (2/11) M/s Rynaa Construction, (3/11) M/s Kishore Bora, (4/11) M/s Gravel, (8/11) M/s Ranu Nandi & (9/11) M/s Amar Bora on 28.11.2024
