

10 Implementation of Domestic Purchase Preference:

As per para-37.1 of ITB (Section-II) CP-43 of Bid Document, Domestic purchase preference shall apply for the purpose of Development of Domestic Industries, Domestic Purchase Preference of 20 per cent shall be allowed.

There has to be a local content of minimum of 60 per cent. To assess purchase preference, the definition brought at CP-43, 44 of bid document shall apply:

- 1) M/s. Johnson has submitted copy of Certificates issued from Cost Accountant dt 13.04.2024 is enclosed at CP-402 stating that the equipments are manufactured 100% locally, using 25.9% of import components.
- 2) M/s. Omega has submitted copy of certificate issued from chartered accountant. M/s. Hitten V. Shah dated 17.08.2024 stating that the local content will be more than 60% (CP-714).

11 Technical Evaluation – Conclusion and Recommendations.

Based on the above analysis of the Technical proposal at Annexure A1 & A2 at Page – 63/14 and 63/7, the bidders are considered “Responsive & Eligible” to the requirement of the bid documents and are recommended to be invited for opening of their price bid for further evaluation of the Most Advantageous Tender. The “Responsive & Eligible” bidder is as follows:

Bidders considered technically responsive & eligible for opening of price bids as mentioned below:

1. M/s. **Johnson Lift Pvt. Ltd.**, 1, East Main Road, Anna Nagar, Western Extension, Chennai – **For LOT I & II BOTH.**

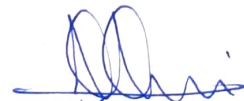
