Minutes of meeting of Bid Evaluation committee held on 03/06/2024 of Technical Bid evaluation for the Work "Performance Based maintenance Contract work to NH-10 Ranipool to Gangtok from KM 80+000 to KM 92+040 (Length = 12.04 KM) & NH-10, 9th Mile Bypass Road from KM 0+000 to KM 5+572 (L=5+572 KM) under National Highway Division III in the state of Sikkim"

Tender Reference no. - 05/CE-NH/RBD/2023-24

Ministry vide letter no. NH-12014/27/2024-RO Guwahati C No. 234205, dated: 12/02/2024 had accorded Administrative approval and Financial Sanction for the work as stated above amounting to Rs. 18.95 Crore. The work is thus proposed under by the state PWD, Government of Sikkim as per Ministry's extant guidelines.

A bid evaluation committee was constituted as per Ministry's Circular No- RW/NH-24035/4/2008-P&M/PIC Vol- II, dated -23rd February 2018, comprising of the following members:

1. The tender for the above-mentioned work was invited by the Chief Engineer (NH), Roads & Bridges Department, Government of Sikkim on 14th March 2024 and opened on 27th March 2024. A total 02(Two) Bids were received online from the following bidders :

2. Due to the ensuing Parliamentary & Assembly elections and the enforcement of the model code of conduct, the evaluation of the bids had been kept on hold. However on receipt of communication from the Ministry vide office memorandum no. NH-15017/20/2023-P&M, dated: 26/04/2024, regarding exemption granted by the ECI for sanction & award of maintenance works, the evaluation of the bids was carried out with the scanned documents uploaded online.
3. Based upon the documents placed before the Evaluation Committee, the committee examined the technical bid of the 02 (Two) bidders (the detailed evaluation sheet is enclosed herewith).
4. Both the bids on evaluation were found to be technically Non-responsive as both the bidder have not submitted any documentary evidence in support of owning/ leased/rented of the equipment to be needed for the maintenance work as per Section-2 of RFP along with fitness certificates. In the absence of the documentary proof of ownership/lease/rent/hire bids cannot be considered responsive. Thus the BEC thus recommend cancellation of the tender.

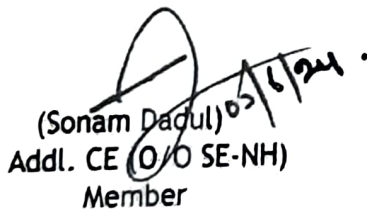
The meeting ended with the vote of thanks by the chair.

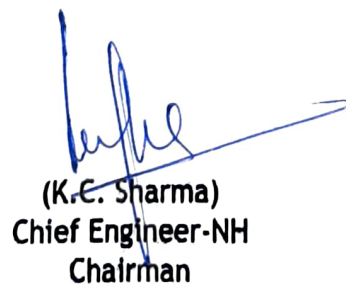
