PROCEEDINGS OF THE TECHNICAL BIDS EVALUATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 30-12-2024 IN THE CHAMBER OF CHIEF ENGINEER, NATIONAL HIGHWAYS, BANGALORE TO EVALUATE THE BIDS RECIEVED FOR THE WORK “Resurfacing of State Highway No-86 Ramanathapura Terakanambi Road from Ch. 124.80km to 129.80km and Resurfacing of State Highway No-81 Yalanduru Gundlupet Road from Ch.50.10km to 55.10km in Gundlupet Taluk approved under CRIF 2023-24 - [Job No: CRIF-KNT-2023-24-291]”.

Preamble:

Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, New Delhi letter in the letter No.RW/BNG/GENL/CRF/121/2020, dated 12.03.2024, has approved the work of Improvements to Road from “Resurfacing of State Highway No-86 Ramanathapura Terakanambi Road from Ch. 124.80km to 129.80km and Resurfacing of State Highway No-81 Yalanduru Gundlupet Road from Ch.50.10km to 55.10km in Gundlupet Taluk approved under CRIF 2023-24 - [Job No: CRIF-KNT-2023-24-291]”, for an amount of Rs.600.00 lakhs and the Secretary, PWD, Govt of Karnataka in the Government order ಸಂಖ್ಯೆ: ಬಿಇಇಂ 6 ಸಿ ಆರ್ ಎಫ್ 2024 (ಇ). ಬೆಂಗಳೂರು, ದಿನಾಂಕ: 29-08-2024 has accorded administrative approval.

Technically sanctioned by the Chief Engineer, National Highways, Bengaluru assigning the sanction No. As CER No.89/2024-25, dated 06.09.2024 for Rs.600.00 lakhs.

Accordingly, Tender was called for the said work by the notification No: EE/NHD/BNG/CRIF/2023-24/2024-25/1304, Date: 06.09.2024, through CPP portal <https://eprocure.gov.in>. Amount put to tender is Rs.485.03 Lakhs and the calendar of events were as here under.

The Technical Bids were opened on 14.10.2024, in response following 6 bidders were participated in the tender.

1. Sri Ashok.S.Mysore.
2. M/s. Futuro Infra Ltd. Bangalore.
3. M/s Selliamman Constructions, Erode Tamilnadu.
4. Sri. Krishna.S Mysore.
5. M/s. Sentur vellan Infrs India Pvt., Ltd. Mysore.
6. M/s. Bapuji, Constructions, Mysore.

The meeting of the Technical Bid Evaluation Committee constituted vide letter dt.31.07.2024 comprising the following members was convened on 31.12.2024 in the chambers of the CE, N.H, Bangalore, to evaluate the technical bids received for the above said work.

The technical bid documents substantiating the qualification criteria indicated in the KW-4 tender document has been verified by the Committee and responsiveness of the bidders as per Technical Evaluation is as follows;

TECHNICAL EVALUATION;

1. Sri Ashok.S.Mysore.

The Committee verified the downloaded Technical Bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The Committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), (4) Banker's certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

But, the Confirmation pertaining to EMD has been received on 04.11.2024 but not fulfils the Bid Capacity as per Clause 3.6. Hence, the Committee opined to consider the bid as technically Non Responsive.

2. M/s. Futuro Infra Ltd. Bangalore.

The Committee verified the downloaded technical bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The Committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), (4) Banker's certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

Further, the Confirmation pertaining to EMD, Work done and Line of Credit has been obtained by the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru and are in line with the submitted Bid documents. Hence, the Committee opined to consider the bid as **Technically Responsive**.

3. M/s Selliamman Constructions. Erode.

The Committee verified the downloaded Technical Bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The Committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), and (4) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

As per the report of the Executive Engineer NH division Bangalore, the Confirmation of EMD not received & Hard copy of Banker's Certificate for credit facilities has not received as per clause 3.3b. Hence the documents submitted by the bidder does not satisfies the conditions as per the Bid Document and is technically **Non Responsive**.

4. Sri. Krishna.S Mysore.

The Committee verified the downloaded Technical Bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The Committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), and (4) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

As per the report of the Executive Engineer NH division Bangalore, the Confirmation of EMD not received & Hard copy of Banker's Certificate for credit facilities has not received as per clause 3.3b. Hence the documents submitted by the bidder does not satisfies the conditions as per the Bid Document and is technically **Non Responsive**.

5. **M/s. Sentur vellan Infrass India Pvt., Ltd. Mysore.**

The Committee verified the downloaded Technical Bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The Committee observed that, said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), (4) Banker's certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

Further, the SBI, Coimbatore has certified that, the certificate w.r.t BG issued to Shri. Senthur Vellan, Infrass India Pvt., Ltd., stands cancelled as they have utilized their full limit as on date vide SBI bank letter dated 27.11.2024. Hence, the Committee opined to consider the bid as **Technically Non Responsive**.

6. **M/s. Bapuji, Constructions, Mysore.**

The Committee verified the downloaded Technical Bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The Committee observed that, said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), (4) Banker's certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

Further, the Confirmation pertaining to EMD, Work done and Line of Credit has been obtained by the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru and are in line with the submitted Bid documents. Hence, the Committee opined to consider the bid as **technically Responsive**.

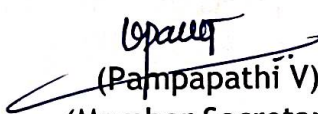
COMMITTEE CONCLUSION:-

After detailed deliberations, as the bids submitted by the bidder's *M/s. Futuro Infra Ltd. Bangalore* and *M/s. Bapuji, Constructions, Mysore*, are in line with the uploaded bid documents the Technical bid Evaluation Committee has resolved to consider these Two bidders as Technically Responsive.

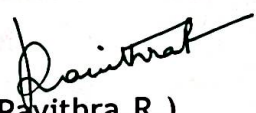
Whereas, *Sri Ashok.S.Mysore, M/s Selliamman Constructions, Erode Tamilnadu*, *Sri. Krishna.S Mysore*, and *M/s. Sentur vellan Infrass India Pvt., Ltd. Mysore*, are considered as **Non Responsive** by the committee, since the documents submitted by the bidders does not satisfies the conditions as per the Bid Document.

Further, Instructions were issued to the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru to open the financial bids of the responsive bidders as per the departmental procedures.

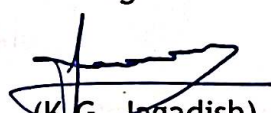
