MINUTES OF THE TECHNICAL BIDS EVALUATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 30-11-2024 IN THE CHAMBER OF CHIEF ENGINEER, NATIONAL HIGHWAYS, BANGALORE TO EVALUATE THE BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE WORK "WIDENING & IMPROVEMENTS TO 4-LANE AND 2LPS OF ROAD SH (HAROHALLI- HUNASANAHALLI- KODIHALLI-KABBALU CHANNAPATNA- BEVUR TO JOIN SH-33) FROM SATHANURU TO 7 CHANNAPATNA TALUK BORDER VIA KABBALU INCLUDING FOUR LANING IN SREE KSHETRA KABBALAMMA TEMPLE FROM KM 93.800 TO KM 95.950 AND KM 96.950 TO KM 102.800 (SELECTED REACHES) IN KANAKAPURA TALUK RAMANAGARA DISTRICT (JOB NO. CRIF-KNT-2023-24-270).

Preamble:-

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has approved 295 Nos of works amounting to Rs.1385.60 Cr vide letter No.RW/BNG/GENL/CRIF/121/2020 Dtd:-12.03.2024. The above works are included in the approved list vide SL No.270 with a sanctioned cost of Rs.600.00 Lakhs.

Further, the Government of Karnataka vide letter No.PW 06 CRF 2024(E), Bengaluru Dtd:-29.08.2024 has accorded Administrative approval for the same by assigning Job No.CRIF-KNT-2023-24-270.

Technical sanction has been accorded by the Chief Engineer, National Highways, Bengaluru vide CER No.45/2024-25.

Accordingly, tender was called for the said work by the notification No: 04/2024-25, Date:-06.09.2024 through CPP portal <https://eprocure.gov.in> by the Executive Engineer, NH Division, Bengaluru.

The technical bid documents substantiating the qualification criteria indicated in the KW-4 tender document has been verified by the committee and responsiveness of the bidders as per Technical Evaluation is as follows;

1. Sri. Arvind Kumar, Class I Contractor, Mandya.

The committee verified the downloaded technical bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), (4) Banker's certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

Further, the Confirmation pertaining to Earnest Money Deposit, Work done and Line of Credit has been obtained by the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru and are in line with the submitted Bid documents. Hence, the committee opined to consider the bid as technically responsive.

2. M/s Bhoomara Constructions, Mysore:-

The committee verified the downloaded technical bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b) and (4) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

But, the bidder has furnished Banker's Certificate for Rs.81.00Lakhs towards Credit Facilities instead of Rs.242.535Lakhs as per clause 3.3b of tender qualification criteria which is less than the required amount. Hence, the committee opined to consider the bid as technically non-responsive.

3. M/s G H N Constructions, Ramanagara:-

The committee verified the downloaded technical bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), (4) Banker's certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

Further, the Confirmation pertaining to Earnest Money Deposit, Work done and Line of Credit has been obtained by the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru and are in line with the submitted Bid documents. Hence, the committee opined to consider the bid as technically responsive.

clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

Further, the Confirmation pertaining to Earnest Money Deposit, Work done and Line of Credit has been obtained by the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru and are in line with the submitted Bid documents. Hence, the committee opined to consider the bid as technically responsive.

9. Sri Chowdeshwari Concrete India Pvt Ltd, Bengaluru:-

The committee verified the downloaded technical bid documents of the bidder as furnished by Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru. The committee observed that, the said bidder has furnished the required documents which are satisfying the tender qualification criteria (1) the bid security, 2) Annual turnover report as per Clause 3.2 (a) of Sec-2, (3) Work done certificate as a single prime contractor as per clause 3.2(b), (4) Banker's certificates for credit facilities as per clause 3.3b, and (5) Plant & equipment capabilities as per clause 3.3(a) of tender document.

Further, the Confirmation pertaining to Earnest Money Deposit, Work done and Line of Credit has been obtained by the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru and are in line with the submitted Bid documents. Hence, the committee opined to consider the bid as technically responsive.

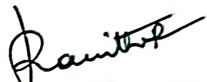
Further, M/s Bhoomara Constructions, Mysore has furnished Banker's Certificate for Rs.81.00Lakhs towards Credit Facilities instead of Rs.242.535Lakhs as per clause 3.3b of tender qualification criteria which is less than the required amount. Hence, the committee opined to consider the bid as technically non-responsive.

Instructions were issued to the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Bengaluru to open the financial bids of the responsive bidders as per the departmental procedures.
