3.0 OBSERVATIONS:-

1. It is noted that **07 (Seven)** Bidders have submitted their bid in e-portal form.
2. It is noted that the Commercial CS was duly vetted on 02/09/2024 in finance.
3. It is noted that the Bidder wise Technical comments were endorsed by Technical Member on 04/09/2024.

4.0 DELIBERATIONS:

4.1 The bidder wise deliberations regarding **Commercial evaluation** as per BEC are given below:

(1/7) M/s Bhyan Construction Co.:-

As per the vetted Techno-commercial CS dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder has fulfilled all the requirements of Commercial BEC except the following:

- a) BEC Matrix
- b) Acceptance that they comply with the provisions with regard to “Guidelines for eligibility of a ‘Bidder from a Country which shares a land border With India’ ”as detailed at Annexure-I “Instructions to Bidders”. Bidder should also submit the requisite certificate as mentioned. (on Company letterhead)
- c) The percentage of local content in the bid in Appendix 16.

In view of the above, it is opined that the bidder may be asked to submit deficient documents as detailed above for further evaluation.

(2/7) M/s Gayatri Construction Co.:-

As per the vetted Techno-commercial CS dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder has fulfilled all the requirements of Commercial BEC.

In view of the above, it is opined that the bid is commercially acceptable.

(3/7) M/s Radhika Construction:-

As per the vetted Techno-commercial CS dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder has fulfilled all the requirements of Commercial BEC.

(4/7) M/s B. V. Chaudhari:-

- b) Undertaking to provide all the necessary compliances/ Invoice/ documents required under GST legislation for enabling ONGC to avail Input tax (GST) credit.

- c) Declaration that neither the bidders themselves, nor any of its allied concerns, partners or associates or directors or proprietors involved in any capacity, are currently serving any banning orders issued by ONGC debarring them from carrying on business dealings with ONGC.

In view of the above, it is opined that the bidder may be asked to submit deficient documents as detailed above for further evaluation.

(5/7) M/s Sarjan Infratech:-

As per the vetted Techno-commercial CS dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder has fulfilled all the requirements of Commercial BEC except the following:

- a) BG with all the Points as per Format given in Tender Document

In view of the above, it is opined that the bidder may be asked to submit deficient documents as detailed above for further evaluation.

(6/7) M/s Himanshu J. Gupta:-

As per the vetted Techno-commercial CS dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder has fulfilled all the requirements of Commercial BEC.

In view of the above, it is opined that the bid is commercially acceptable.

(7/7) M/s Everest Infrastructure Co.:-

As per the vetted Techno-commercial CS dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder has fulfilled all the requirements of Commercial BEC.

In view of the above, it is opined that the bid is commercially acceptable.

4.2 The bidder wise deliberations regarding **Technical evaluation** as per BEC are given below:

(1/7) M/s Bhyan Construction Co.:-

 - 1. Work Order and Completion certificate for “Any work consisting of Construction or Repair of any type of Roads” as per BEC clause B.2.1(a)-I (i)

In view of the above, it is opined that the bidder may be asked to submit deficient documents as detailed above for further evaluation.

(2/7) M/s Gayatri Construction Co.:-

- a. As per the Technical comments dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder is meeting the eligibility and experience criteria of BEC

In view of the above, the bid is technically acceptable.

(3/7) M/s Radhika Construction:-

- a. As per the Technical comments dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder is meeting the eligibility and experience criteria of BEC

(4/7) M/s B. V. Chaudhary:-

- a. As per the Technical comments dated 02/09/2024, it is observed that the bidder is not meeting the eligibility and experience criteria of BEC clause B.2.1(a)-I (i).

 - 1. Work Order and Completion certificate for “Any work consisting of Construction or Repair of any type of Roads” as per BEC clause B.2.1(a)-I (i)

In view of the above, it is opined that the bidder may be asked to submit deficient documents as detailed above for further evaluation.

(5/7) M/s Sarjan Infratech:-
