

RECOMMENDATION OF TEC FOR ANNUAL AFLOAT REPAIR OF ANCHOR PONTOON – VI, VII, VIII FOR THE YEAR 2025-26

NIT for Annual Afloat Repair of Anchor Pontoon – VI, VII, VIII was published on 26th July 2025 on IWA website and e-procurement portal. In response to the NIT, following 6 (six) bidders submitted their bids on the scheduled date and time i.e., 19th August 2025 at 1230 hrs, which is the last date of submission of the offers:

Detailed statement of the bid documents submitted / uploaded by the above bidders viz a viz tender criteria have been prepared and placed as Annex – I.

From the above comparative statement, M/s Vav World, Meerut, Ghaziabad (1/2) has not submitted few requisite documents i.e. valid Bank solvency, similar work experience, Certificate Registered with any major port of India and Registration/incorporation certificate of the Company, ESIC & EPFO registration certificate and M/s Om Shiv Sai Enterprise (4/6) has not submitted Certificate Registered with any major port of India. Hence, their bids may be considered as technically disqualified.

Considering the current repair work during FY 2025-26, M/s Das Consultancy & Agency Services has been awarded with 4 nos. vessels for Annual afloat repair during the month of June 2025 – Aug 2025 and during review, the progress of repair work is found to be very slow and till date repair work has not been completed. In spite submitting all the requisite documents, the firm may not be considered qualified technically due to the slow progress work.

From the detailed statement, 3 (three) bidders, as mentioned below, have adequate experience and has submitted all mandatory documents.
