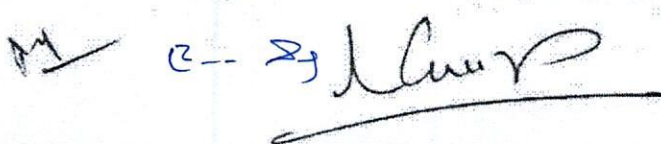


Minutes of meeting for Evaluation of Technical bids held on dt. 17-06-2025 in the Chairmanship of Chief Engineer-Regional Officer, MoRT&H, Dehradun for the "Rehabilitation and Up-gradation from single lane to two lane with paved shoulder from existing Km 195.175 to Km 220.00 (Design Chainage from Km 71.300 to Km 95.947 Paligad to Jankichatti) on NH 134 in the state of Uttarakhand under EPC mode."

2. The work "Rehabilitation and Up-gradation from single lane to two lane with paved shoulder from existing Km 195.175 to Km 220.00 (Design Chainage from Km 71.300 to Km 95.947 Paligad to Jankichatti) on NH 134 in the state of Uttarakhand under EPC mode" was sanctioned vide Ministry's letter No. NH-134-UR-2017-18-524/2(Comp.No.- 247381) dated 16.05.2025 for Rs. 344.73 Cr, (Job. No. NH-134/UR/2017-18-524). The cost of work proper was Rs. 25761.64 Lakh (Excluding GST).
3. The tender for the instant work was invited as per Ministry's Guidelines by the Superintending Engineer, 10th N.H. Circle, PWD, Dehradun vide letter No. 66/13Yata-NH-10/2024 dated 08.01.2025 and Corrigendum No.- 1630/13Yata-NH-10/2025 dated 14.05.2025 with online bid submission date of 29.05.2025 and online bid opening scheduled date as 30.05.2025.
4. Member Secretary informed that the following 07 (Seven) bidders submitted their bid online as below: -
 - (i) M/s ABCI Infrastructures Pvt. Ltd., DN-23 2nd Floor, Sector-V, Salt Lake, Kolkatta-700091.
 - (ii) M/s. Oasis Projects Limited JV with M/s DMR Builders Pvt. Ltd Plot N/A. 1217, Unity Square, JLPL Industrial Area, Sector-82, SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab, 140308.
 - (iii) M/s Punia Construction Company, H. NO 30, SECTOR-13, PART-2, HISAR (Haryana) 125001.
 - (iv) M/s. R.G Buildwell Engineers Limited B-30, RDC Rajnagar Ghaziabad – 201002 UttarPradesh, India.
 - (v) M/s. S&P Infrastructure Developers Private Limited JV with M/s Yahsmitta Infrastructure and Developers Private Limited, 907, 9th floor, New Delhi House, 27, Barakhamba Road, Connaught Place, New Delhi-110001.
 - (vi) M/S Shiva Buildtech Private Limited JV with M/s Rajesh Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd & M/s Vikesh Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd 226A, D-288-89/10, Laxmi Nagar, Wadhwa Complex, Vikas Marg, New Delhi-110092.
 - (vii) M/s Shivalik Buildtech Private Limited JV with M/s Altis Holding Corporation, A-2/516, Ekta Gardens, Near Mother Dairy, Patparganj, New Delhi-110092.
5. The committee deliberated and recommended through its MoM dt. 30.05.2025 that the Technical Bids of above 07 (Seven) Bidders to be opened online on dt. 30.05.2025.



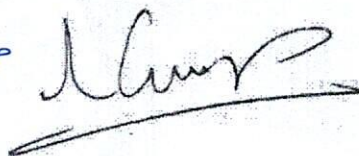

6. Member secretary informed that after opening the technical bids of above 07 (Seven) Bidders the necessary/requisite documents of all bidders have been verified as per RFP at division level.
7. Member Secretary informed that the similar nature work experience submitted by the bidder namely M/s Punia Construction Company, H. NO 30, SECTOR-13, PART-2, HISAR (Haryana) 125001 is not in accordance with Clause No-2.2.2.2 (ii) of RFP. Clause 2.2.2.2(ii) of RFP states that "Provided that at least either of the following: (i) two similar completed works costing not less than amount equal to 25% each of estimated cost, (ii) one similar completed work costing not less than amount equals to 35% each of estimated cost, shall have been completed from the Eligible Projects in Category 1 and/or Category 3 specified in Clause 2.2.2.5. Certificate(s) from the concerned client(s) shall be required for the same. In case the claimed project (s) are subcontracting / JV project in such a case Approval from Govt. Authority / Client is required (restricted to allowable sub- contracting limit/ JV share in original contract). For this purpose, a project shall be considered to be completed, if more than 90% of the value of work has been completed and such completed value of work is equal to or more than the above mentioned criteria in the last 5 (five) financial years preceding the Bid Due Date or till the Bid Due Date." Therefore, as per this clause two eligible projects in category 1 or 3 each having completed value of work more than Rs. 64.41Cr or one eligible project in category 1 or 3 having completed value of work more than Rs. 90.17 Cr were required to be submitted by the bidders as similar nature work experience. But the none of the eligible projects (Project Code – A to J) submitted by the bidder namely M/s Punia Construction Company, H. NO 30, SECTOR-13, PART-2, HISAR (Haryana) 125001 in its bid fulfill the above criteria.
8. Member Secretary informed that –
 - 8.1 The Joint Bidding Agreement for Joint Venture submitted by the bidder namely M/S Shiva Buildtech Private Limited JV with M/s Rajesh Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd & M/s Vikesh Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd 226A, D-288-89/10, Laxmi Nagar, Wadhwa Complex, Vikas Marg, New Delhi-110092 is not in accordance with the cl. 2.1.11 (c) of RFP. Clause 2.1.11 (c) of RFP states that "Members of the Joint Venture shall nominate one member as the lead member (the "Lead Member"). Lead Member shall met at least 60% requirement of Bid Capacity, Technical and Financial Capacity, required as per Clause 2.2.2.1, 2.2.2.2(i) & 2.2.2.3. The nomination(s) shall be supported by a Power of Attorney, as per the format at Appendix-III, signed by all the other Members of the Joint Venture. Other Member(s) shall meet at least 20% requirement of Bid Capacity, Technical and Financial Capacity required as per Clause 2.2.2.1, 2.2.2.2(i) & 2.2.2.3 (except otherwise specified in RFP) and the JV as a whole shall cumulatively/collectively fulfil the 100% requirement; Provided further that, In the case of a Joint Venture (JV), each member is required to hold a minimum of 26% (twenty six percent) In the JV." Point No.- 06 of the Joint Bidding Agreement for Joint Venture submitted by the bidder in its bid states that "The Parties agree that the proportion of construction in the EPC Contract to be allocated among the members shall be as follows: First Party: 60%, Second Party: 20%, Third Party: 20%. Further, the Lead Member shall itself undertake and perform at least 51 (fifty one) per cent of the total length of the project highway if the Contract is allocated to the Joint Venture."

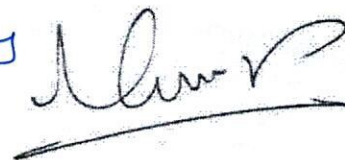
8.2 Also, each of the eligible projects submitted by M/s Rajesh Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd. (JV Member) as eligible projects (i.e., Project code A to H) for fulfilment of technical capacity criteria are having receipts below Rs 25.76 crore, hence can not be considered in technical experience as per cl. 2.2.2.6 (ii) of RFP. Clause 2.2.2.6 (ii) of RFP states that - *"For a project to qualify as an Eligible Project under Categories 3 and 4, the Bidder should have received payments from its client(s) for construction works executed, fully or partially, or work executed and certified by the Engineer-in-charge/Independent Engineer/Authority's Engineer during the 5 (five) financial years immediately preceding the Bid Due Date, and only the amounts (gross) actually received/ work executed, during such 5 (five) financial years shall qualify for purposes of computing the Experience Score. However, receipts of work executed amount less than Rs. 25.76 crore (Rs. Twenty-Five crore and Seventy-Six Lakh only) shall not be reckoned as receipts for Eligible Projects. For the avoidance of doubt, construction works shall not include supply of goods or equipment except when such goods or equipment form part of a turn-key construction contract / EPC contract for the project. Further, the cost of land and also cost towards pre-construction activities (like shifting of utilities etc.) shall not be included hereunder."*

9. On the basis of merits and reasons mentioned above the Technical Evaluation Committee observed that the following 02 (two) bidders are technically non-responsive: -

- (i) M/s Punia Construction Company, H. NO 30, SECTOR-13, PART-2, HISAR (Haryana) 125001.
- (ii) M/S Shiva Buildtech Private Limited JV with M/s Rajesh Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd & M/s Vikesh Kumar Contractor Pvt. Ltd 226A, D-288-89/10, Laxmi Nagar, Wadhwa Complex, Vikas Marg, New Delhi-110092.

10. The Technical Evaluation Committee in this meeting observed the technical bids of following 05(Five) bidders are meeting the norms specified as per clause 2.2 of RFP and also referred documents submitted as per 3.1.6 of the RFP. Hence following 05(Five) bidders were found technically responsive.

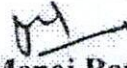
