

Minutes of the meeting held online at 5PM on 04.04.2025 to deliberate upon the price bids received against the project "Landslide Treatment work of 01 location at Km. 116 on NH-109 (Old NH-87Ext.) (Chhara Village) under EPC Mode in the State of Uttarakhand under Annual Plan 2024-25"

In compliance of the decision taken by the evaluation committee, the financial bids of the captioned project was opened on 02.04. 2025. The bidders quoted their bid price as tabulated below:

Immediately after the opening of the price bids, the L1 bidder, HMBS Textiles Private Limited furnished a letter dated 02.04.2025 to the Superintending Engineer, National Highway Circle, Haldwani claiming that due to technical system error/glitch, the zeros have been omitted from the price bid leading to the aforesaid position and has requested the bid evaluation committee to annul its bid as *non-est* and reopen the financial bid with rightful successful bidder.

To deliberate upon this peculiar situation, the online meet was convened by the member secretary and the following was the attendance :

The committee considered the claim of the L1 bidder and concluded that if the zeros were omitted due to a system error or technical glitch, then the figure quoted would have been 2898 and there would not be a decimal point after 28. The other bidder's entered price has as many zeros as they entered. Therefore, the claim of the L1 bidder is not sustainable. Hence, the bid evaluation committee decided to annul the bidding process and invite fresh bids and forfeit the bid security of the L1 bidder.
