Member Secretary apprised the evaluation committee that tender was invited on 12.03.2025 with bid date of 06.05.2025. Accordingly technical bid was opened on dated 07.05.2025. 1st evaluation committee meeting was held on 02.06.2025. Accordingly, minutes of meeting was uploaded on CPPP portal and Infracon portal. In 1st evaluation, out of 10 bidder, 6 bidders were declared responsive and 4 bidders declared were non responsive.

2.1 In reference to 1st Evaluation Committee Meeting held on 02.06.2025 w.r.t technical evaluation on the subject cited consultancy services and subsequent representations received from concerned bidders, the 2nd Evaluation Committee Meeting was held on 24.06.2025 by the Evaluation Committee members wherein the representation received from the bidders were deliberated and discussed.

2.2 Member Secretary apprised the Committee that M/s Theme Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd., in association with Ishita Info Solutions Pvt. Ltd., was initially found non-responsive due to not uploading of the mandatory training course certificate of DPR for their Team Leader on the Infracon portal. In this context, Theme Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd., vide letter no. Theme/MoRTH/DPR Odisha/2025/2493 dated 11.06.2025, enclosed a MoRTH circular dated 07.04.2025 and requested for reconsideration of bid evaluation. As per the Ministry's circular dated 07.04.2025, Chief Engineers and above of MoRTH/NHAI/BRO/Chief General Managers/State PWD are exempted from the DPR training at IAHE. Accordingly, the CV of the Team Leader and other key personnel were re-evaluated and found Responsive.

2.3 Member Secretary further apprised that other bidders had also submitted their representations, which were re-evaluated and discussed in detail. Accordingly, their scores have been updated.

3.1 Based on the recommendation of the Evaluation Committee, the technical scores have been updated and is as under : -

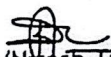
