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1. The Chairman welcomed the Committee members and requested Member Secretary to deliberate on the Technical Bids for consideration/decision of the Committee.
 2. The SE (NH) Chennai has apprised the committee that, the modifications in qualification criteria was issued for EPC projects by the MoRTH vide circular No. RW/NH-24036/28/2025-BP&SP (Computer No.248457) dated 29th April 2025 and amendment regarding additional performance security was issued by MoRTH vide circular no RW/NH-33044/34/2024-S&R (P&B) (Computer No.246283) dated 30th April 2025. However these amendments could not be incorporated in the RFP. The tender was opened on 14.05.2025 as per scheduled date.
 3. The Committee deliberated the above issue and noted that the above amendments issued by the Ministry should have been incorporated in the draft RFP & Agreement. Therefore, the Committee has decided to annul the instant tender and directed the SE (NH) Chennai to invite fresh tender with minimum 4 weeks time period as per GFR.
