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Minutes of meeting of Evaluation committee held on 23.06.2025 under the chairmanship Chief Engineer, MPRDC Bhopal for evaluation of technical bids for the Short-Term Maintenance Contract from Km 82.400 to km 187.993 km (Sidhi to Singrauli section) of NH-39 in the state of Madhya Pradesh.

The subject cited work was sanctioned by the Ministry for Rs.12.18 Cr. (including GST) vide Job No NH-39-MP-STMC/2025-26/20 Dt:04/06/2025

2. The bids for the above work amounting to Rs.998.63 Lakh excluding GST (amount put to tender) were invited by CE(BOT) MPRDC Bhopal vide TN. No. Sidhi-Singrauli/Maintenance/2025-26 dated 13/05/2025 (Tender ID: - 2025_MoRTH_859862_1) with bid due date on 10/06/2025. The bids were available for downloading from official portal of MoRT&H <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> from 13.05.2025 to 10.06.2025. The last date for submission of documents in hard copy was 11.06.2025 upto 15:30 hrs. Thereafter, the technical bids were opened on 11.06.2025 at 16:30 hrs. in accordance with Tender Document and it was noted that 06 (six) no. of bids were received as follows:

- (i) M/S Singrauli Mineral Products Pvt. Ltd., Singrauli
- (ii) M/S AXLE Engineering Pvt. Ltd., Satna
- (iii) M/S Classic Infrastructure, Rewa
- (iv) M/S Kaushal Prasad Patel, Rewa
- (v) M/S Ganesh Pratap Singh, Sidhi
- (vi) M/S Nitin Barsainya, Jabalpur

3. The Meeting of the Evaluation Committee, chaired by the Chief Engineer (BOT) MPRDC Bhopal. The Member Secretary presented the comparative statement before the Evaluation Committee. The Member Secretary apprised the Evaluation Committee that bid is based on **Short Term Maintenance Contract (STMC)** document. It was also apprised to the Evaluation Committee that total 06 nos. of bidders have uploaded the bid document.

4. It was apprised to the Evaluation Committee that as per requirement of Tender documents Cl 12.2, the bidders are required to submit original documents in physical form shall be submitted in a sealed envelope on or before the Bid Due Date and before the time of submission as specified in NIT at the address indicated in **Clause 20** as well as online.

5. It was apprised to the Evaluation Committee that to qualify for award of the contract, each bidder in its name should have the following; -

- a) achieved a minimum average annual financial turnover (in all classes of civil engineering construction and maintenance works only) equal to the amount indicated in NIT during last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year duly certified by Chartered Accountant.
- b) satisfactorily completed (not less than 90% of contract value), as a prime contractor or as a partner of JV for similar works during last five years ending last day of month

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previous to the one in which bids are invited, either of the following:

- i. three similar completed works costing not less than amount equal to Rs.249.66 lacs each.
- ii. two similar completed works costing not less than amount equal to Rs 349.52 lacs each.
- iii. one similar -completed work costing not less than amount equal to Rs 499.32 lacs.
- iv. (the similar work constitutes construction/maintenance of roads)

(C) Each bidder must upload the scanned copies of following documents along with the submission of online bid:

- i. An affidavit on a Stamp Paper, duly attested from the Notary Public, that the information furnished with the bid documents is correct in all respects; and
- ii. Such other certificates as defined in Section-3. Failure to submit the certificates/documents as specified above shall make the bid non-responsive.

(D) Each bidder must demonstrate for this work:

- i. evidence of availability (either owned or leased or rented) of the key equipment for this work as stated in the Appendix to ITB.
- ii. availability of personnel with qualification and experience as stated in the Appendix to ITB

6. Member secretary further appraised the committee that technical evaluation of all the 06 (six) Bidders and their results of Responsiveness/ Non-Responsiveness are as follows:

3.	M/S Classic Infrastructure, Rewa	Non-Responsive	Bidder has submitted the BG of Bid security valid up to 15.10.2025. According to CI 16.2, the Bidder is disqualified from the tender due to having the BG with a validity period of less than 165 days.

M/S Kaushal Prasad Patel, Rewa	Non-Responsive	Cl. 21.1 any document in physical form if received by the Employer after the deadline prescribed in Clause 20 will be returned unopened to the Bidder and also the e-bid submitted by such bidder shall not be considered. Since the bidder failed to submit the physical documents upto scheduled time, hence bid is considered as non-responsive.
