

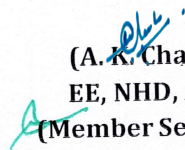

Out of the 5 projects claimed by the Lead member "SUNNY INFRAPROJECTS PRIVATE LIMITED" for technical capacity, the JV member "GOLDSAND" has claimed 2 projects for technical capacity. Both the projects have been sub contracted to Sunny by the concessionaire and are further sub sub-contracted by Sunny to Goldsand and completion certificate provided by Sunny itself. No prior approval for sub contract or clear communication has been given to GOLDSAND by the authority for whom work is done as required under Point 32(c) Appendix 1A of RFP and Article 5.2.5 of DCA of HAM. 2. Bidder has not submitted the Bid Security in the format Appendix-II & also Bidder has given Demand Draft for Bid Security whose validity is only 3 months. The Bidder claims that since the Bid Security has been submitted in the form of a Demand Draft, submission of Appendix-II /Appendix-IX (Bank Guarantee format) is not applicable in their case. Further, the validity period of a Demand Draft is governed by Reserve Bank of India (RBI) guidelines, under which a Demand Draft remains valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. 3. We further noticed that the Bid Security DD of amount is drawn in favour of "The Chief Engineer Public Works Department" while it should be drawn in favour of "PAY & ACCOUNTS OFFICER (NH)" as per page 71 of RFP
