

MINUTES FOR EVALUATION OF TECHNICAL BIDS HELD ON 13th August, 2025

NAME OF WORK:- : “One time Improvement of Shillong-Jowai Road (NH-44) from Km 54.200 to Km 69.200 (Length = 15.00 Km) in the state of Meghalaya (Job No. 44/MG/2024-25/178)”

(A) Bidding Process:-

Bid Value: Rs. 20.14 Cr. (Excluding GST and inclusive of Labour Cess).

Consequently upon receipt of approval from MoRTH New Delhi Vide No.NH-12014/149/2024-RO Guwahati (C.no. 246218) Dated 26.03.2025 and Technical Note Dated 27th March, 2025 MoRTH (Nort-East Zone) New Delhi. The Chief Engineer (NH) P.W.D (Roads), Meghalaya, Shillong Vide PW/CE/NH/16/2024/11 Dated 22.05.2025 and Tender ID: 2025_MoRTH_861233_1 dated 22.05.2025. The NIT, IFB and RFP were made available in the CPPP, MoRTH [https:// eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app](https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app) from 22.05.2025 at 18.00 Hrs. to 20.06.2025 (upto 14.00 Hrs. IST).

i) Pre-Bid Meeting :

The Pre-Bid Meeting was held on 2nd June, 2025 at 14:00 Hrs. as per schedule and no bidder was present in the pre-bid meeting.

ii) Date stipulated for receiving the bid document:

The deadline for submission of online bid was upto 20.06.2025. 14.00 Hrs IST.

(iii) **Technical Bid opening:** - The online technical bid was opened on 23.06.2025 at 14:00 Hrs in the Office chamber of Chief Engineer (NH) P.W.D (Roads). Total 8 (Eight) Nos. of bidder was received through online mode in the portal of [https:// eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app](https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app), namely:

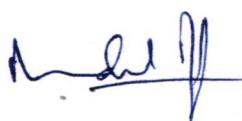

(B) Evaluation of Technical Bids: -

1. To establish the responsiveness of each & every individual's technical bids, the qualification information submitted online by the bidders have been examined on the basis of technical qualification criteria laid down in the bidding documents and compiled in the form of a statement -“TABLE FOR EVALUATION OF SUBSTANTIVE RESPONSIVENESS OF TECHNICAL BIDS” to be placed before the Bid Evaluation Committee.

2. The Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC) held on 13th August, 2025 at 12:00 P.M. in the Office chamber of Chief Engineer (NH) P.W.D (Roads) through VC in presence members of Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC).

3. The Technical Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC) verified the documents and examined the technical bids & all other relevant papers and after brief discussion, the deliberation of the Bid Evaluation Committee is as under:-



(i) **M R Construction** : The bid document has been examined and it is observed that the cost of bid does not mention any date in it. No specific project information or evidence has been provided in support of the bidder's claim of technical capacity, as per the format at Annex-IV of Appendix-1A. No project-wise certificate from statutory auditors has been furnished as per the prescribed format for claims of technical capacity. Statement of legal capacity has not been submitted. The average turnover of the bidder (updated to the price level of the year) for the last five years is less than the required value. The bidder has not submitted any similar work as per Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii). The threshold capacity is less than ₹15.11 crore, as per Clause 2.2.2.2 (i). Details of the bidder, as per Annex-I, have not been submitted. Accordingly the bidder is declared as technically non responsive.

(ii) **Shri. Nibatskhem Marang**: Bid Documents are found to be in order

(iii) **M/S P K and Company**: Bid Documents are found to be in order

(iv) **Purbanchal buildtech Pvt. Ltd**: Bid Documents are found to be in order

(v) **RGS Construction**: The bid document has been examined and it was observed that the threshold capacity is less than Rs.15.11 crore, as required under Clause 2.2.2.2 (i). The bidder has submitted only one similar work of whereas Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) requires at least two similar completed works costing Rs.5.04 crore each. The Bank Guarantee submitted by the bidder is incomplete. Accordingly, the bidder is declared as technically non responsive

(vi) **Megh Infrastructure**: Bid Documents are found to be in order

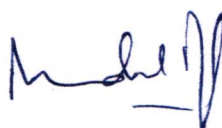
(vii) **M/S Spantek**: The bid document has been examined and it was observed that the bidder has not submitted the statement of legal capacity as per format in Annex-V of Appendix-1A. Accordingly the bidder is declared as technically non responsive

(viii) **M/S TANOR ENGINEERING**: Bid Documents are found to be in order.

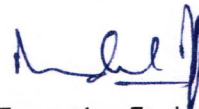
In view of the above the BEC has decided to open the Financial Bids of the technically responsive bidders.
