

Minutes of Meeting of Evaluation Committee held on 30.07.2025 at 03:00 pm under the chairmanship of Chief Engineer (NH), MP PWD, Bhopal for technical evaluation of bids for the work Maintenance Contract on Daboh-Bhander-Chirgaon Length 45.63 km on NH-552 Ext. in the state of Madhya Pradesh on Performance Based Maintenance Contract (PBMC) mode.

“Job no. (NH-552EXTN-MP-PBMC-2024-25-05” Tender ID 2025_MoRTH_861815_1 Date 27.05.2025

The subject cited work was sanctioned by the Ministry for Rs.59.87 Cr vide Job No. NH-552EXTN-MP-PBMC-2024-25-05, date-04.12.2024.

2. The bids (RFP) for the above work amounting to Rs. 4621.45 Lakh excluding GST(amount put to tender) were invited by EE, PWD NH Division Gwalior vide NIT no.16/SAC/Tender/NHGWL/2025-26 Dated: 27.05.2025 with bid due date on 25.06.2025. The bids were available for downloading from official portal of MoRT&H <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Thereafter, the technical bids were opened on 03.07.2025 and it was noted that total 10 (ten) no. of bids were received as follows:

3. The Meeting of the Evaluation Committee, chaired by the Chief Engineer (NH), MP, PWD Bhopal was held on 25.07.2025 at Nirman Bhawan, Bhopal. The Member Secretary presented the comparative statement before the Evaluation Committee. The Member Secretary apprised the Evaluation Committee that bid is based on **Performance Based Maintenance Contract (PBMC)** document. It was also apprised to the Evaluation Committee that total 10 nos. of bidders have uploaded the bid document.

4. It was apprised to the Evaluation Committee that as per requirement of NIT, the bidders are required to submit a Power of Attorney as per format at Appendix –III authorizing the signatory of the bid to commit the bidder, Bid Security of ₹ 46.21 Lacs (Rs. Forty-Six lacs twenty-one thousand Only) in the form of Original Bank Guarantee in the format defined at Section-4 of RFP and copy of online receipt towards payment of cost of Bid document of ₹11,800/- (Rupees Eleven Thousand Eight Hundred Only) in original as well as online. The member secretary has further apprised that the bid security submitted by above bidders have been verified from the concerned banks.

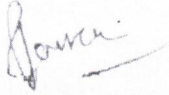
5. It was apprised to the Evaluation Committee that submission in support of financial capacity of a bidder should be as per requirement of Clause 4.9 of RFP document, which is reproduced as under:

- (i) The Technical Bid must be accompanied by the Audited Annual Reports of the Bidder (of each Member in case of a Joint Venture) for the last 5 (five) financial years, preceding the year in which the bid is submitted.
 - (ii) In case the annual accounts for the latest financial year are not audited and therefore the Bidder cannot make it available, the Bidder shall give an undertaking to this effect and the statutory auditor shall certify the same. In such a case, the Bidder shall provide the Audited Annual Reports for 5 (five) years preceding the year for which the Audited Annual Report is not being provided.
 - (iii) The Bidder must establish the minimum Net Worth specified in Clause 4.4 of section-2 of ITB of RFP and provide details as per format at Annex-III of Appendix-IA.
6. It was apprised to the Evaluation Committee that submission in support of technical capacity, similar work & eligible experience on eligible projects in respect of each category by the bidder, should be as per requirement of Cl.4.3& Cl.4.7 of RFP document respectively, which is reproduced as under:
- (i) For demonstrating technical capacity and experience (the “Technical Capacity”), the Bidder shall, over the past 5 (five) financial years preceding the Bid Due Date, have received payments for construction of Eligible Project(s), or has undertaken construction works by itself in a PPP project, such that the sum total thereof, as further adjusted in accordance with clause 4.6 (i) & (ii), is more than the tendered / Bid value (i.e. ₹ 4621.45 Lacs, ₹ Forty six crore twenty one lacs forty five Thousand Only).

- (ii) **For normal Highway projects:** Provided that at least one similar work of **20%** of Estimated Project Cost i.e. **₹ 924.29 Lacs (₹ Nine Crore Twenty-Four Lacs twenty-nine thousand only)** shall have been completed from the Eligible Projects in Category 1 and/or Category 3 specified in Clause 4.6. For this purpose, a project shall be considered to be completed, if more than 90% of the value of work has been completed and such completed value of work is equal to or more than 20% of the tendered/Bid value. However, for 4 lane or above configurations projects, experience of the eligible projects in Category 1 and/ or Category 3 shall be of 2 lane or more. For projects with lane configuration up to 2 lanes with paved shoulder, all experience of the Eligible Projects in Category 1 and/ or Category 3 shall be considered irrespective of lane configurations.
- (iii) It was also apprised to the committee that as per cl.4.7 (ii), For a project to qualify as an Eligible Project under Category 3, the Bidder should have received payments from its client(s) for construction/maintenance works executed, fully or partially, or work executed and certified by the Engineer-in-charge/Independent Engineer/Authority's Engineer during the 5 (five) financial years immediately preceding the Bid Due Date, and only the amounts (gross) actually received/ work executed, during such 5 (five) financial years shall qualify for purposes of computing the Experience Score. However, receipts of or work executed amount less **than 5% of Bid Value i.e. ₹ 231.08 Lacs (₹ Two Crore Thirty-one Lacs Eight thousand only)** shall not be reckoned as receipts for Eligible Projects. For the avoidance of doubt, construction/maintenance works shall not include supply of goods or equipment except when such goods or equipment form part of a turn-key construction contract / EPC contract for the project.
7. Member secretary further apprised the committee that technical evaluation of all the 10 (ten) Bidders and their results of Responsiveness/ Non-Responsiveness are as follows:

8. It was apprised that as per the available records known to the committee, none of the 09 responsive bidders are debarred or blacklisted and all bidders have valid bank guarantees, which have been duly verified by the respective banks.
9. In view of above, the Evaluation Committee chaired by the Chief Engineer (NH), MP PWD Bhopal deliberated the technical evaluation of bids and recommended the nine (09) bidders as technically qualified for opening of their financial bids.
10. Committee further decided that result of technical evaluation shall be informed to the bidders by uploading on the CPPP portal giving 7 days' time for objections, if any, from the bidders.
11. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.



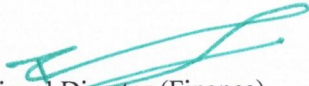
