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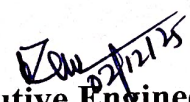

Minutes of the Meeting of the Bid Evaluation Committee held on 03.11.2025 at 15.30 Hrs for technical evaluation of the Bids received for the work of "Consultancy services for Preparation of Detailed survey investigation & preparation of DPR including L.A. & other clearance for construction of ROB at Km 17.00 (Goagachi) on NH 131A in the State of Bihar".

A meeting of the Bid Evaluation Committee was held on 03.11.2025 at 15:30 hrs under the Chairmanship of the Chief Engineer-cum-Regional Officer, Patna (MoRTH), to evaluate the technical bids received for the above-mentioned consultancy work.

2. Member Secretary informed the committee that tender was floated for the subject work vide NIT dated 31.05.2025. The bid due date of the subject work was 30.06.2025 and technical bids was opened on 01.07.2025. Following were the bids received:

- I. M/s CADD Consulting Engineers Pvt. Ltd. in association with Green Design & Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd.
- II. M/s CEOMA Consulting Pvt. Ltd. in JV with Sparsh Engineering Co. Pvt. Ltd. In association with Prithvig Infra Consultant Pvt. Ltd.
- III. M/s Civil Mantra Infracon Ltd.

3. Member Secretary further informed that the initial technical evaluation of bids was carried out in the Committee meeting held on 09.09.2025 and technical result technical evaluation were uploaded on web portal as per clause 12.3 of Data Sheet of RFP on 16.09.2025. Representation from all 3 bidders were received and the same was forwarded to M/s Calculus Consultants Pvt Ltd. for further examination.

4. Member Secretary informed the committee that Financial Consultant, M/s Calculus Consultants Pvt Ltd. has examined the representation submitted by the bidders and has submitted their response & draft evaluation sheet vide email dated 06.10.2025.

During the meeting, following deliberations were made:

- I. The Committee deliberated upon the evaluation carried out by M/s Calculus Consultants Pvt. Ltd. in light of the representations submitted by the bidders and as per the provisions stipulated in the RFP and its subsequent addendums. The Committee examined the eligibility and technical qualification criteria and reviewed the marks awarded to each firm accordingly.
- II. The committee found following bidders as Responsive/ Non-Responsive to the RFP Criteria:

Sl no	Name Of Bidder	Status	Remarks
1	M/s CADD Consulting Engineers Pvt. Ltd. in association with Green Design & Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd	Responsive	The Consultant had earlier evaluated the proposal based on normal highway criteria instead of the Stand-alone Bridge criteria, leading to lower TL marks i.e 64 (<75). Upon review, the Team Leader's CV the revised evaluation updated the TL marks to 90. Accordingly, making the bidder responsive.
2	M/s CEOMA Consulting Pvt. Ltd. in JV with Sparsh Engineering Co. Pvt. Ltd. in association with Prithvig Infra Consultant Pvt. Ltd.	Non-Responsive	The bidder did not submit the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) as part of the technical bid. As per Clause 5.1 (vii) of the Letter of Invitation (LOI) of the RFP.

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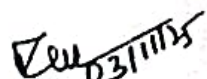
			Although the bidder submitted the MoU subsequently in their representation, the requirement was to submit the MoU at the time of the technical bid submission. Since this condition was not fulfilled at that stage, and the clause explicitly mandates disqualification in such a case, the bidder is accordingly declared non-responsive.
3	M/s Civil Mantra Infracon Ltd.	Non-Responsive	The marks assessed for the bidder was 64.02 which has been revised to 66.24 after representation. The bidder does not meet the minimum eligibility criteria as per clause 5.2 of LOI of RFP.

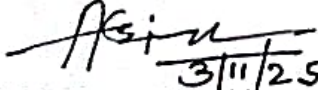
4. After detailed deliberation, the Committee observed that only one bidder (M/s CADD Consulting Engineers Pvt. Ltd. in association with Green Design & Engineering Services Pvt. Ltd.) was found technically responsive. Considering that the bid evaluation resulted in a single responsive bid, the Committee recommended that the tender may be annulled and fresh bids may be invited to ensure wider competition and participation of more competent bidders.
