Minutes of the Evaluation Committee meeting for the Evaluation of Financial Bid for the work of “Strengthening from Km 22/0 to 78/0 of NH-38 (Length 54.223km) (Mangalore –Villupuram Road) on EPC mode in Tamil Nadu on EPC Basis Contract under Annual Plan 2024-2025 in Tamil Nadu” (Job No. NH-38-TN-2024-25-1039)

Estimate Amount: Rs.7103.15 Lakh Value Put to Tender: Rs.5551.50 Lakhs

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1. The Chairman welcomed the Committee members and requested Member Secretary to deliberate on the Financial Bids for consideration/decision of the Committee. Accordingly, the Member Secretary explained the details of Financial Bids received.
2. The tender received through online for the above work was opened by the Evaluation Committee on 17.07.2025. The technical bid was evaluated by the Tender Evaluation Committee on 28.07.2025 and 13.08.2025. After Evaluation, the Committee decided to declare the technical bids of (1) M/s. Suganya Constructions and (2) M/s. Babuji Civil Construction as “Responsive”. The bids of Thiru.P.Paramasivam and M/s. Budha Infra Developers Pvt. Ltd., were declared “Non-Responsive”

3. The Committee directed the Superintending Engineer (NH) Chennai to upload the results of technical evaluation in e-procurement portal. The Superintending Engineer (NH) Chennai informed the Committee that the results of technical evaluation were uploaded in CPPP and the date of opening of financial bids was fixed on 20.08.2025 @ 15.00 Hrs. SE (NH) Chennai informed the committee than no representations were received from any of the bidders.
4. As per clause 2.2.2.1 of RFP, Superintending Engineer (NH) Chennai has sought updated value of "B" as on 19.08.2025, of the above responsive bidders. The Superintending Engineer (NH) Chennai has informed the Committee that the bidders (1) M/s. Suganya Constructions and (2) M/s. Babuji Civil Construction have submitted the updated value of "B".

The updated Bid Capacity status as on 19.08.2025 furnished by the bidders is tabulated below:

5. The Financial bid of the above responsive bidders were opened by the Committee through V.C. on 20.08.2025 as notified. The Committee evaluated the financial bid of the bidders and the results are tabulated below:

6. After evaluation of the financial bids, the committee found that the bid of M/s. Babuji Civil Construction, amounting to Rs.55,51,53,000/- (Exclusive of GST) which works out to be at Estimate rate (2023-24) put to tender is the lowest bid. Accordingly, the Committee recommended the lowest bid of M/s. Babuji Civil Construction amounting to Rs.55,51,53,000/- (Rupees Fifty Five Crore Fifty One Lakh and Fifty Three Thousand only) (Exclusive of GST) for seeking approval of Competent Accepting Authority.

The financial bids of 2 (Two) bidders are enclosed.
