

Minutes of meeting of Evaluation Committee held on 24-10-2025 evaluation of financial bids for the work " Consultancy services for preparation of DPR for the works of (i) 4L Spur to Khatu from Shahpura (NH-48) in the state of Rajasthan (tentatively 60km) (ii) Bypass/realignment of Alwar, Viratnagar, Naugaon etc. and rectification of accident spots/blackspots on Hanuman circle to Bagad tiraya section of NH-248A (tentatively 25km) (iii) Realignment of Atru town and widening of remaining 2L sections to 2L+PS of Baran - Aklera section of NH-752 (Length -35km tentatively) (iv) Repair and rehabilitation of existing Hameer ROB on NH-552Ext. and existing Amjhar bridge on NH-52 in the State of Rajasthan (length - 1km tentatively) (v) 4 laning from km 0 to km 57 of Fatehpur-Jhunjhunu section of NH-11 (Length - tentatively 57 km) in the State of Rajasthan" held on 07-10-2025 at Regional Office Jaipur. The bids for the above Consultancy work were invited online by the O/o Regional Officer, MoRTH with bid due date on 16-08-2025 as per extant norms. The Technical bids were opened on 18-08-2025 and technical evaluation done by the Committee was uploaded on CPPP portal on 07-10-2025. Representations from bidders were received, same were replied vide email or scoresheets were explained physically to the bidders in line with RFP as given below:

5. Regarding, reasonableness of the prices, the Evaluation Committee has deliberated following:

5.1 **Normative Cost:** The subject consultancy services cover a total length of 178 km, comprising several and geographically dispersed works located across different terrains. The Ministry, vide Circular No. H-39011/30/2015-P&P(Pt-1) dated 12.03.2019, has prescribed normative costs per kilometre as follows:

5.2 The Evaluation Committee noted that, the Cost Rs 312.94 Lakhs quoted by the H-1 bidder is within the Normative Cost of Rs 587.0 Lakhs.

6. After above deliberations, Evaluation Committee recommended the following for the approval of Competent Authority:

(i) To accept the bid of FP India Project Management in association with M/s TTL Engineering Pvt. Limited as Most Preferred Bidder (H-1 Bidder) at their quoted price of Rs. 2,65,20,500/- (Rupees Two Crore Sixty-Five lakh Twenty thousand five hundred only) exclusive of GST for subject consultancy services.

(ii) Performance security and Addl. performance security shall be sought from the H1 bidder as per clause 6.1 and 6.2 of RFP.

(iii) To submit the tender based estimate to Ministry for seeking approval of Competent Authority in compliance to para-1.2 of Ministry circular no. NH-15017/17/2016-P&M dated 27.03.2025.

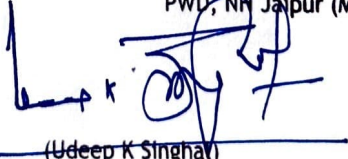
