

Minutes of Meeting of Screening Committee held on 10.04.2026 at 1:00 PM through hybrid mode for the screening of the technical bids as carried out by the State Level Evaluation Committee for the work of "Rehabilitation and up-gradation to 4-lane configuration of Kashipur to Ramnagar road from km 5.735 to km 24.00 of NH-121 (km 64.735 to km 83 New NH-309) (18.265 km) on EPC Mode in the state of Uttarakhand under NH(O)"

Meeting of the Screening Committee was held on 10.04.2026 at 1:00 PM through hybrid mode under the chairmanship of Chief Engineer North-I, MORTH New Delhi for the Screening of the technical bids of the bidders as carried out by the State Level Evaluation Committee. 2. At the outset, the Chief Engineer (North-I), MoRTH, New Delhi welcomed all the participants. Member Secretary apprised that the technical, administrative and financial sanction to the instant project amounting to Rs. 494.45 Cr was issued by Ministry's letter No. RO/UK/AnnualPlan/2023-24/Haldwani/06(Comp No. 233607) dated 12.03.2024.

3. Bids for the work with civil cost of Rs. 299.06 crore (excluding GST and including 1% labour cess), was invited by the Superintending Engineer, N.H. Circle, PWD, Haldwani, vide NIT No. 2945/12M-NH/2025 dated 08.08.2025 and corrigendum No. 3869/12M-NH/2025 dated 25.10.2025 through the CPP Portal, as per the delegation in the Ministry's circular dated 23.02.2018. The last date for bid submission was 27.11.2025.

4. Technical bids were opened on 26.12.2025 on CPP Portal. 21 nos. of bidders have participated as per the following details:

5. Earlier, the Committee, in its meeting held on 23.03.2026, deliberated upon the evaluation of the State Level Committee, as recommended in its meeting held on 11.03.2026, wherein the Committee declared 04 bidders as non-responsive for the reasons detailed below:

Now State level Committee in its meeting held on 06.04.2026 recommends that the following 03 bidders also do not fulfil the eligibility requirements of the RFP, as detailed below:

6	M/s VELJI Ratna Sorathia Infra Private Limited	Non-responsive as per Clause 2.1.17 of RFP as the Office of the Chief Engineer, NH, PWD, Bhopal, vide letter dated 20.02.2026, has debarred the firm for a period of one (01) year from participating in National Highway projects and other Centrally Sponsored Road Works (CSRW).
7	M/s R&C Infraengineers Private Limited	The bid is considered non-responsive, as the tender fee has not been submitted in accordance with Clause 1.2.4 of the RFP.

The Screening Committee deliberated on the evaluation done by the State Level Evaluation Committee and observed that all above 7 bidders did not meet the criteria mentioned in the RFP. Accordingly, the 7 bidders are declared Non-responsive.

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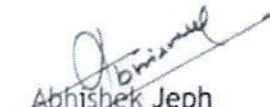

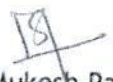

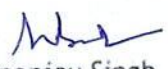
