

Proceedings of the Meeting for evaluation of Technical Bid for the work of “Short Term Maintenance of Kiratpur Sahib – Sri Anandpur Sahib – Nangal Road upto Mehatpur (HP Border) from Km 44.700 to 80.420 of NH-503 (Extn.) in State of Punjab for 2025-26” (Job No. NH-503 Extn-PB-2025-2026-586 dated: 16.07.2025).

Sanctioned Cost: Rs. 260.12 Lacs (Amount put to tender: Rs. 1,95,71,302/- excl GST)

1. The Bid Evaluation Committee as constituted by Department of Finance, Government of Punjab, Chandigarh vide its letter endst. no. 4220-25 dated: 17.06.2022 & letter endst. no. 750816/TA S-1(Addl. Charge) 2025/3525-31 dated: 28.04.2025 to evaluate the technical bids is as below:-

2. The Administrative Approval and financial sanction amounting to Rs. 260.12 Lakh for the subject cited work was conveyed by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRT&H) vide their letter no. NH-15017/43/2025-P&M dated: 08.07.2025. The Technical Note of the work was issued by the Regional Officer, MoRT&H, Chandigarh vide their letter no. RW/CH/PB/W(121)/2025-26 (Comp. No. 232512)/827-36 dated: 16.07.2025. The DNIT document was also got examined from O/o Chief Engineer (NH), PWD (B&R) Br., Patiala vide letter no. 1662/NH dated 11.08.2025. Accordingly, bids was invited by the Executive Engineer by online mode through <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> vide Tender Notice No. 01 dated 12.08.2025 with estimated cost of Rs. 1,95,71,302/- (excluding GST), Bid Security of Rs. 1,95,713/-, Tender Fee Rs. 11,800/- and duration of work including maintenance as 12 Months.

3. The Member-II-cum-Convener intimated the bid evaluation committee that Pre-Bid meeting was scheduled on 18.08.2025, but neither the prospective bidder attended nor any queries received via e-mail/letter. The technical bid was opened on dated: 11.09.2025 and it was found that only one single bidder has submitted its bid online i.e. through <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

4. The Member-II-cum-Convener further intimated the bid evaluation committee that as per the Punjab Transparency in Public Procurement (Amendment) Rules, 2024 notified on 06.02.2024, the number of bidders qualifying in technical evaluation shall not be less than two in first bidding. However, MoRT&H circular dated: 28.08.2024, provides that lack of completion shall not be determined solely on the basis of the number of Bidders and that even when only one Bid is submitted, the process should be considered valid provided following conditions are satisfied:-

5. In this connection, regarding the single bid received for the subject cited work the Member-II-cum- Convener provided justification with respect to the MoRT&H circular provisions as follows:-

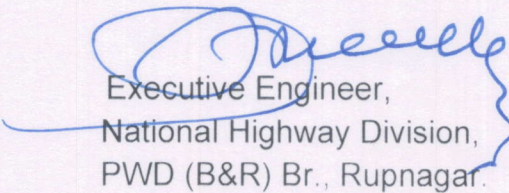
(i) The tender/procurement was satisfactorily advertised for 30 days on Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) i.e. <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> as per Regional Officer, MoRT&H, Chandigarh letter no. RW/CH/PB (Misc)/02/851-53 dated: 22.07.2025. The notice was also advertised on MoRT&H BIMS portal as per norms.

(ii) The qualification criteria was not unduly restrictive and was based on Ministry guidelines for Contract Document for Short Term Maintenance of NHs.

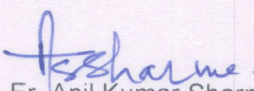

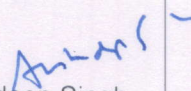
The brief of which is given below:-

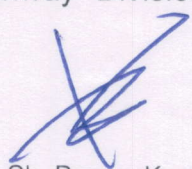
Sr. No.	Name of Agency	Responsive/ Non-Responsive

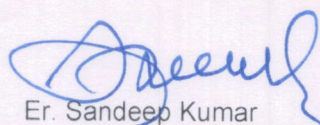
