a Demand Draft (DD) drawn in the name of Road Transport and Highways and not in the name of RPAO (NH), Mumbai. The matter was discussed with RPAO (NH), Mumbai and it has been informed that submission of the Tender Fee through Demand Draft is not acceptable in its current form, as it does not comply with the prescribed format.
