Minutes of Meeting of Tender Evaluation Committee (Final Financial Evaluation) dated 29.04.2025 for the work of "Construction of Foot Over Bridge at Km 382+510 near the Gandhigram Rural Institute, Chinnalapatti and Permanent Rectification of Blackspot TN-02-282 by Construction of Service road from Km 410/680 to Km 411/260 along with new Minor Bridge on BHS, Junction Improvement, Highway Lightings, other safety appurtenances, etc., in Dindigul to Samayanallaur section of NH-44 (TN-05) in the State of Tamil Nadu (2nd Call)" (Tender Ref. No. NHAI/17011/01/119/2025/RO Madurai).

1. The Committee have decrypted the financial bids submitted by technically qualified bidders on 12.04.2025 and amounts quoted by them and the percentage below or above w.r.t. value put to tender (Rs.9,75,41,845/-) are as under;

2. Consequent upon approval of Competent Authority to seek justification & Rate Analysis towards the rate quoted by M/s Prithvi and Co., Madurai i.e. 36.10% less than the estimated amount, the bidder was directed vide RO-Madurai Letter No. NHAI/17011/01/119/2025/RO Madurai/E-261019/661 dated 12.04.2025 to furnish the justification & Rate Analysis to carry out further evaluation.

3. In response, M/s Prithvi and Co., Madurai has furnished the justification with Rate Analysis in support of their quoted price vide letter no. PAC/DS/NH-44/01 dated 18.04.2025 and the same has been examined by the Committee. The bidder has submitted that they have all owned machineries used for the construction of road projects, own stone quarry crushers and own RMC Plant, accordingly they quoted low rates. However, the bidder has not submitted the rate justification for Structural Steel Works w.r.t. Construction of FOB in the subject tender work. Also, justification for lower quoted rates of Steel, Bitumen, Fine and Coarse Aggregates, Road Furniture items, etc., has not been furnished. In their submitted Rate Analysis, the bidder has considered material rates lower than market rates without overhead charges for BC works & TMT Steel reinforcement for Structure works. In recent days, the rates of construction materials are increased in Tamil Nadu State, hence, the reduction of material rates lower than the approved rates are not acceptable/justifiable. Considering the above, further evaluation was not carried out by the Tender Evaluation Committee.

In view of the above, the Tender Evaluation Committee recommends to annul the instant tender process in order to create awareness amongst the bidders to have a healthy competition in quoting the bid price without taking a call on quality aspect and to invite fresh bids under third call duly giving 30 days time for bid submission.
