3.	M/s K.G. Gupta Infrastructure Pvt. Ltd.	Disqualified Bidder has been considered as Disqualified for the following reasons. 1. Bidder has not submitted the Fitness Certificates of the MMUs which is required as per Appendix to ITB of Section 2 of RFP. Therefore, in the absence of the Fitness Certificate of MMUs Submitted, Bidder is not meeting the criteria mentioned in Note to clause 4.1(j)(1) of Appendix to ITB of section 2 of RFP.
4.	M/s Kaiser Constructions Engineers and Contractors	Disqualified Bidder has been considered as Disqualified for the following reasons. 1. The bidder has submitted supporting documents for one MMU only, the second MMU has not been submitted, Bidder has submitted an undertaking in this regard, However, As per the note mentioned at the end of clause (4.1j)(1) of RFP "The bidder must upload scanned copy of the documentary evidence in support of his owning/ leased/rented of the above equipment along with fitness Certificates" and it is also mentioned in the same clause that "Any conditional evidence of deployment of above equipment or inadequate proof as required for any of the equipment shall make the bid non-responsive and financial bid shall not be opened" Hence, in view of the above mentioned clause the Undertaking submitted by the bidder has not been considered. 2. Bidder has submitted proof of Semi Automatic Drum Mix Mobile Plant DM35 (35-45) TPH instead of 1 Mini hot mix plant (6/10 T/Hr capacity) with indirect heating arrangements which is required as per clause 4.1 j (1)(a). of section 2 of ITB. 3. Bidder has not submitted any proof in support of 1 Static Roller, having the capacity of 8/10 T. Which is required as per clause 4.1 j (1)(a). of section 2 of ITB.
5.	M/s Saraswati Buildcon	Qualified
6.	M/s AK Shivhare Infrastructure Pvt Ltd	Disqualified Bidder has been considered as Disqualified as per clause 4.1 (d) of RFP as Bidder has not submitted Fitness certificates in support of the both MMUs. which is required as per Note to clause 4.1.(j)(1) to Appendix to ITB of Section 2 of RFP. Therefore, in the absence of the Fitness Certificate for MMU, Bidder has been considered as Disqualified as per clause 4.1 (d) of RFP.

7.	M/s Mahavir Prasad Gupta And Sons	Disqualified Bidder has been considered as Disqualified for the following reasons. 1. The CV submitted in the Reply indicates a total experience of 69 months (5 years and 9 months) as Incident cum Road Property Manager cum Route Operation Manager, however project-wise designation has not been provided which is required as per Note to clause 4.1(j)(2) of Appendix to ITB of Section 2 of RFP. 2. The CV submitted in the reply reflects a total of 104 months (8 years and 8 months) of experience in highway projects, it does not clearly specify the designations held (i.e., Project Manager/Team Leader) in each project. The resubmitted CV is identical to the original and lacks the required designation-wise breakdown which is required as per Note to clause 4.1(j)(2) of Appendix to ITB of Section 2 of RFP.

12.	M/s KK Gupta Constructions Pvt Ltd	Disqualified Bidder has been considered as Disqualified as per clause 4.1 (d) of RFP. Bidder has not submitted the Fitness Certificates of the MMUs which is required as per Note to Clause 4.1(j)(1) of Appendix ITB of Section 2 of RFP. Bidder has submitted an undertaking in this regard, However, As per the note mentioned at the end of clause (4.1j(1) of RFP "The bidder must upload scanned copy of the documentary evidence in support of his owning/ leased/rented of the above equipment along with fitness Certificates" and it is also mentioned in the same clause that "Any conditional evidence of deployment of above equipment or inadequate proof as required for any of the equipment shall make the bid non-responsive and financial bid shall not be opened" Hence, in view of the above mentioned clause the Undertaking submitted by the bidder has not been considered. Therefore, in the absence of the Fitness Certificate for MMU, Bidder is not meeting the criteria mentioned in Note mentioned under Clause 4.1(j)(1) of Section 2 of ITB of RFP.
13.	M/s M M Construction Company	Disqualified Bidder has submitted the POA in its Bid however the same has not been executed on stamp paper and in the reply Bidder has submitted that it is not required to execute the POA on stamp paper which is unjustified. Hence the same may not be considered. Bidder may be considered non-responsive as per the Note mentioned below Appendix-III of RFP in which it is clearly mentioned that it has to be executed as per the Applicable law (Indian Stamp Act 1899) which requires to execute the POA to be executed on stamp paper
