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6.2 As per conditions laid in the RFP, the bidder who downloads the RFP document from the website will be required to pay the non - refundable fee (cost of bid document) of Rs.10,000/- through online mode of payment as per Clause 3 of Invitation for Bids (IFB) & Bid Security of Rs.27,00,000/- as per Clause 17 of Section - I, Instruction to Bidders (ITB) in the form of Insurance Surety Bonds, Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee (including e- Bank Guarantee) from any of the Commercial Banks or online payment, having a validity period of not less than 180 (one hundred eighty) days from the BID Due Date. While submitting Bid Security via Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque, it is to be ensured by the bidder that Account Payee demand draft or Fixed Deposit Receipt or Banker's Cheque are submitted physically latest within 5 working days of the Bid Due Date.

6.4.1 M/s. Aasma Enterprises:

As per conditions laid in the RFP, the bidder who downloads the RFP document from the website will be required to pay the non - refundable fee (cost of bid document) of Rs.10,000/- through online mode of payment as per Clause 3 of Invitation for Bids (IFB) & Bid Security of Rs.27,00,000/- as per Clause 17 of Section - I, Instruction to Bidders (ITB).

As per Corrigendum - 10, Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE Procurement Policy issued by Department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or are registered with the Central Purchase Organization or the concerned Ministry or Department or Startups as recognized by Department for Promotion of Industry Policy &



Promotion (DIPP) is exempted from submission of Bid Security as per Revised Rule - 170 of General Financial Rules - 2017. However, in place of Bid Security, the Bidders require to sign a Bid Security Declaration (Format Enclosed as Annexure) accepting that if they withdraw or modify their bids during the period of validity, or if they are awarded the contract and they fail to sign the contract, or to submit a Performance Security before the deadline defined in this Bid Document, then the bidder will be suspended for participation in the tendering process for the works of MORTH / NHAI / NHIDCL and works under other centrally sponsored schemes, for a period of as decided by NHAI.

Accordingly, the bidder has submitted the copy of certificate claiming that they have been registered under MSME. The same has been verified by the Committee and found to be in order. However, the bidder has not submitted Bid Security Declaration Form as specified above.

The Evaluation Committee opined to proceed with further evaluation as the firm has submitted MSME Certificate.

6.4.2 M/s. Shri Sai Industries:

As per conditions laid in the RFP, the bidder who downloads the RFP document from the website will be required to pay the non - refundable fee (cost of bid document) of Rs.10,000/- through online mode of payment as per Clause 3 of Invitation for Bids (IFB) & Bid Security of Rs.27,00,000/- as per Clause 17 of Section - I, Instruction to Bidders (ITB).

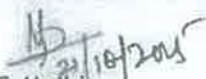
However, on verification it is observed that the bidder has not submitted Bid Security of Rs.27,00,000/- as per Clause 17 of Section - I, Instruction to Bidders (ITB).

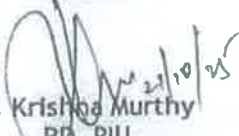
In this regard, Clause 17.4 of Section - I, Instruction to Bidders (ITB) stipulates that, "Any Bid not accompanied by an acceptable bid security shall be summarily rejected by the Employer as non - responsive".

Hence, the Evaluation Committee opined to consider the bid of the bidder as Non - Responsive.

7. Finance Wing vide note dated 21.10.2025 confirmed the receipt of tender fee and Bid Security of the other bidders.

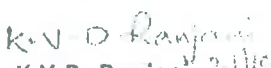

Minutes of Meeting of Tender Evaluation Committee (Technical Evaluation) dated 28.10.2025 for "Providing Solar Highway Lighting at 104 nos. of locations in the stretch from Km 741.255 to Km 1022.494 on Anakapalli - Annavaram - Diwancheruvu section of NH-16, Diwancheruvu - Siddhantham - Gundugolanu section of NH-216A, Gundugolanu - Devarapalli - Kovvuru from Km 15.320 to Km 85.204 section of NH-16 and Kathipudi - Start of Kakinada Bypass from Km. 0.000 to Km. 27.500 section of NH 216 in the State of Andhra Pradesh, as part of rectification of MoRT&H identified Blackspots & Accident spots on item rate (percentage) basis" (Tender Ref. The Evaluation Committee met on 15.10.2025 for carrying out detailed technical evaluation of the bids, except for the bidder M/s. Shri Sai Industries who was considered as Non - Responsive in Pre-Technical Evaluation.

2. The deliberations of the Committee are as follows:

2.1 M/s. Aasma Enterprises:

2.1.1 As per Clause 1.3.2 under Section - IX. Form for Qualification Information & Corrigendum - 01, "The Bidder shall have generated a minimum average annual construction turnover during the last 3 years (commencing from the year 2021-22) equivalent to Rs.4.00 Crores".

However, on verification it is observed that the bidder is having turnover of only Rs.2.13 Crores during last 3 years as against the minimum requirement of Rs.4.00 Crores. Further, it is also observed that the bidder has submitted the Statutory Auditor certificate on the letter head of the bidder in proof of turnover which is not acceptable.

2.1.2 As per Clause 1.3.1 (b) under Section - IX. Form for Qualification Information & Corrigendum - 10, "The Bidder shall provide evidence that it has successfully completed or substantially completed within the last five years (commencing from the year [2019-20]), either of the following:

However, on verification of the Experience Certificates submitted by the Bidder, it is observed that no work experience is meeting the above requirements in respect of estimated cost.

2.1.3 As per Clause 3.1 of Section - I. Instructions to Bidders (ITB), "Eligibility of bidders is based on bidder meeting the pass/fail criteria regarding their general and particular experience, financial position, personnel and equipment capabilities and other relevant information as demonstrated by the applicant's responses on the forms attached in Section IX (Volume 3)".

On verification it is observed that the bidder has not submitted requisite information in the prescribed formats attached in Section IX (Volume 3).

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Hence, the Evaluation Committee recommends to consider the bid of the bidder as Non - Responsive.

2.2 M/s. Bondada Engineering Limited:

2.2.1 As per Clause 1.3.1 (b) under Section - IX. Form for Qualification Information & Corrigendum - 10, "The Bidder shall provide evidence that it has successfully completed or substantially completed within the last five years (commencing from the year [2019-20]), either of the following;

As per Clause 3.1 of Section - I. Instructions to Bidders (ITB), "Eligibility of bidders is based on bidder meeting the pass/fail criteria regarding their general and particular experience, financial position, personnel and equipment capabilities and other relevant information as demonstrated by the applicant's responses on the forms attached in Section IX (Volume 3)".

Accordingly, the bidder has submitted requisite information in the prescribed formats attached in Section IX (Volume 3).

On verification it is observed that the work represented by the bidder as completed work is showing progress of 85% as against the requirement specified under Clause 1.3.1 (b) of Section IX (Volume 3). Further, the same work was not shown in the list of ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of the works for which BID is invited for assessing the available bid capacity as per Clause 1.11 of Section IX (Volume 3).

In view of the above, the Committee recommended to obtain clarification from the bidder as per Clause 28 of Section - I. Instruction to Bidders (ITB) whether the considered work was completed or ongoing work as on Bid Due Date duly substantiating with supporting documents.

2.3 M/s. Dhinra Brothers (India):

2.3.1 As per Clause 1.3.1 (b) under Section - IX. Form for Qualification Information & Corrigendum - 10, "The Bidder shall provide evidence that it has successfully completed or substantially completed within the last five years (commencing from the year [2019-20]), either of the following;

As per Clause 3.1 of Section - I. Instructions to Bidders (ITB), "Eligibility of bidders is based on bidder meeting the pass/fail criteria regarding their general and particular experience, financial position, personnel and equipment capabilities and other relevant information as demonstrated by the applicant's responses on the forms attached in Section IX (Volume 3)".

Accordingly, the bidder has submitted requisite information in the prescribed formats attached in Section IX (Volume 3) except forms - 4A & 10.

However, on verification it is observed that the works considered by the bidder are of Conventional Street Lighting and Road Furniture works which does not meet the requirement in respect of nature of similar work.

2.3.2 As per Clause 1.3.2 under Section - IX. Form for Qualification Information & Corrigendum - 01, "The Bidder shall have generated a minimum average annual construction turnover during the last 3 years (commencing from the year 2021-22) equivalent to Rs.4.00 Crores".

As per Qualification Information Form - 2. General Construction Experience Record B - Annual Turnover Data (from Solar Highway / Solar Street / Solar High Mast lighting / Solar Home Energy System / Solar Home Lighting System works alone).

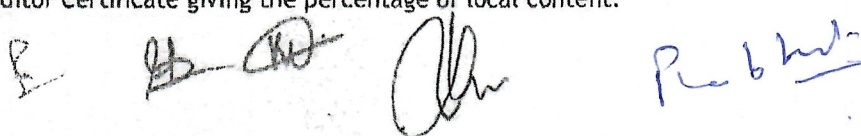
However, on verification it is observed that the bidder is not having any turnover in respect of Solar Highway / Solar Street / Solar High Mast lighting / Solar Home Energy System / Solar Home Lighting System works alone.

Hence, the Evaluation Committee recommends to consider the bid of the bidder as Non - Responsive.

2.4 M/s. Lord's Mark Industries Limited:

2.4.1 As per Clause 3.1 of Section - I. Instructions to Bidders (ITB), "Eligibility of bidders is based on bidder meeting the pass/fail criteria regarding their general and particular experience, financial position, personnel and equipment capabilities and other relevant information as demonstrated by the applicant's responses on the forms attached in Section IX (Volume 3)".

Accordingly, the bidder has submitted requisite information in the prescribed formats attached in Section IX (Volume 3) except form - 11 & form - 13, Form of Bid and Appendix to Bid duly filled in and signed by Authorized Signatory on each page as per section-V & Certification from the Statutory auditor giving the percentage of local content. However, the bidder has uploaded RFP duly signed on each page wherein the above formats are there except Statutory auditor Certificate giving the percentage of local content.



In this regard, RFP Clause 2.4 of Section - I. Instructions to Bidders (ITB) stipulates that, "..... In case, bidder has not submitted the aforesaid certification the bidder will be treated as 'Non- Local Supplier'".

2.4.2 As per Clause 1.11 of Section - IX, "The available bid capacity of the bidders will be assessed. The bidders to be eligible for award of work shall have the bidding capacity more than the total estimated cost of the works i.e., Rs.13.19 Crore. The available BID capacity will be calculated as per the following, based on information mentioned at Qualification Form - 11.

Assessed Available Bid Capacity = $(A \times N \times 2.5 - B + C)$

On verification it is observed that, the bidder has not submitted requisite information mentioned at Qualification Form - 11. However, uploaded the details of works in hand and their progress.

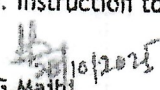
As per Clause 28 of Section - I. Instruction to Bidders (ITB), "To assist in the examination, evaluation, and submission of the Bids and qualification of the Bidders, the Employer may, at its discretion ask any Bidder for a clarification of its Bid. Any clarification submitted by a bidder that is not in response to a request by the Employer shall not be considered. The Employer's request for clarification shall be in writing or by email and the response of the Bidder shall first be submitted by email and later on to be submitted physically along with bid documents i.e. after declaration of Bid Evaluation Result by the Authority. No change in the prices or substance of the bid shall be sought, offered, or permitted, except to confirm the correction of arithmetic errors discovered by the Employer in the evaluation of the Bids, in accordance with Clause 31".

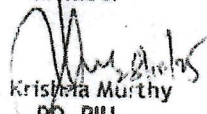
In view of the above, the Committee recommended to obtain clarification from the bidder as per Clause 28 of Section - I. Instruction to Bidders (ITB).

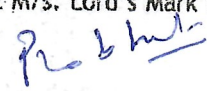
