2	M/s Khalatkar Construction Infra (P) Ltd.- M/s A B Infrabuild Ltd. (JV) The Lead Member of the Consortium 'M/s Khalatkar Construction Infra (P) Ltd.' claimed 03 (three) projects in its Annex-II: Technical Capacity. Out of these three claimed projects, clarifications were sought with respect to Project-A and Project-C. <u>Project-A:</u> The Lead Member was required to clarify the basis for categorizing the said project under Category-3, as per Clause 2.2.2.5(iii)(a) of the RFP. The Bidder, in its reply, submitted an experience certificate issued by the Client, dated 27.02.2024, wherein the project has been identified as a Highway, specifically SH-321. Consequently, the project has been categorized under Category-3, in accordance with Clause 2.2.2.5(iii)(a) of the RFP. <u>Project-C:</u> The work receipts certified by the Statutory Auditor of the Lead Member are less than Rs. 41.04 Crore. As per Clause 2.2.2.6(ii) of the RFP, read along with Corrigendum-4 issued by the Authority, work receipts or executed amounts of less than Rs. 41.04 Crore during the last 5 (five) financial years preceding the Bid Due Date shall not be considered as receipts for Eligible Projects. Accordingly, clarification was sought from the Lead Member on how it meets the requisite Threshold Technical Capacity, as stipulated under Clause 2.2.2.2(i) read with Clause 2.2.2.4(i) of the RFP. In its reply, the Bidder has acknowledged that Project-C was inadvertently included in Annexure-II: Technical Capacity and has undertaken that the revised Threshold Technical Capacity shall be assessed by excluding Project-C. In view of the Bidder's reply and the Statutory Auditor's and Client Certificates submitted for Project-A and Project-B at the time of bid submission and during the clarification stage, the Technical Capacity of the Bidder has been assessed as less than the minimum required Threshold Technical Capacity of Rs. 246.22 Crore (i.e. 60% of Rs. 410.36 Crore). Accordingly, the Bidder does not meet the Threshold Technical Capacity requirement, as stipulated under Clause 2.2.2.2(i) read in conjunction with Clause 2.2.2.4(i) of the RFP, thereby rendering the Bidder Non-Responsive.
6	M/s Skylark Infra Engineering (P) Ltd. The Bidder 'M/s Skylark Infra Engineering (P) Ltd.' claimed projects (Projects A to G) in its Annex-II: Technical Capacity. Out of these, the following project had been assessed as demonstrating experience of one similar completed work amounting to 35% of the Estimated Project Cost, i.e. Rs. 143.63 crore: Project-D: In support of the claimed project, the bidder submitted an experience certificate issued by General Manager (P), NHIDCL, PMU, Kargil, vide letter no. NHIDCL/PMU-KGL/K-Z Road (NH-301)/PKG-07/25-26/495 dated 19.09.2025, at the time of bid submission. As per NHA Policy Circular No. 11.74/2025 dated 04.09.2025, "Experience Certificates issued by other Departments on or after 08.08.2025 shall be strictly in the prescribed format only."

	However, the bidder did not submit the experience certificate in the format prescribed under Annexure-IX of Appendix-IA of the RFP, as required under Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of the RFP and the aforesaid NHA Policy Circular. Accordingly, clarification was sought from the bidder to submit the experience certificate in the prescribed format, duly certified by the Client/Authority, for the purpose of evaluation. However, the Bidder neither submitted any clarification nor provided any supporting documents, including the requisite Client Certificate. In the absence of the required Client Certificate in the prescribed format under Annexure-IX of Appendix-IA of the RFP, the Bidder's experience of having completed one similar work in accordance with Clause 2.2.2.2(ii) of the RFP could not be established. In view of the above, the Bidder fails to meet the Similar Work experience requirement as stipulated under Clause 2.2.2.2(ii) of the RFP, thereby rendering the Bidder Non-Responsive. Further, the bidder has not submitted the following documents, despite the clarification sought: (a) Value of B certified by the Statutory Auditor as on Bid Due Date of the Project (b) Client Certificates/Stage Payment Statements w.r.t projects claimed under the table of Value of B (c) Statutory Auditor Certificate w.r.t Local Content requirement as on Bid Due Date of the Project (d) Undertaking, as required under Clause 2.1.14 of the RFP. (e) Project Specific Undertaking as per Clause 2.11.1 (j) of the RFP.

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
