This has reference to RFP application submitted for the above subject project. The list of Responsive & Non Responsive bidders is as under:

As per Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of the RFP, the bidder is required to have either completed two similar works of at least Rs. 78.47 crore each or one similar completed work of at least Rs. 109.86 crore from Eligible Projects under Category 1 and/or Category 3. Further, the similar work must include the following components in Himalayan or similar geology:

(a) Installation of Self Drilling Hollow Soil / Rock Anchors in hilly /mountainous terrain; and

- (b) Supply & fixing of High Tensile Rolled Cable Net or High Strength Steel wire mesh / synthetic Geomat in hilly / mountainous terrain.

The bidder was required to indicate the relevant page numbers in the submitted bid where the experience certificate, in the prescribed format at Annexure-IX of Appendix-IA of the RFP, could be located, with the mandatory similar work components clearly highlighted in accordance with Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of the RFP.

For the purpose of demonstrating experience of one similar completed work of 35% of the Estimated Project Cost (i.e., Rs. 109.86 crore), the bidder, in its reply, has claimed the following project:

Project: Construction & Up-gradation to 2 Lane with paved shoulder from design Km 31.449 (khellani) (Ex Km 44.946) to Km 51.700 (Prem Nagar) (Ex. Km 68+617) of 20.251 Km length on Khellani - Kishtwar - Chattroo section of NH-244 in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir on EPC mode (Pkg-I).

The bidder has submitted an experience certificate issued by the client in support of the above project, which was also part of the original bid submission. However, upon review, it is observed that the claimed project does not satisfy the Similar Work Experience requirements as stipulated under Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of the RFP.

Further, the experience certificate submitted in the format prescribed at Annexure-IX of Appendix-IA of the RFP is neither certified by the client nor duly authenticated by the bidder.

In view of the above, the bidder fails to meet the Similar Work Experience requirement as per Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of the RFP and is, therefore, considered Non-Responsive.

**** M/s S&P Infrastructure Developers (P) Ltd.**

As per Clause 2.2.2.1 of the RFP, "Bidders who, inter alia, meet the minimum qualification criteria shall be qualified only if their available Bid Capacity is greater than the total Bid Value (i.e., Rs. 313.89 crore)."

In the present case, the bidder did not submit the table indicating the value of all existing commitments and ongoing works (i.e., Value of 'B') as part of its original bid submission. In the absence of Value of 'B', duly certified by the Statutory Auditor and the Authorized Signatory of the bidder, the Bid Capacity of the bidder could not be ascertained. Accordingly, a clarification was sought from the bidder regarding the non-submission of Value of 'B'.

In response, the bidder has submitted the Value of 'B', duly certified by the Statutory Auditor and the Authorized Signatory, along with supporting documents. The Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) provided on the submitted certificate has been verified from the ICAI portal, and it is observed that the UDIN was generated on 20.03.2026, while the certificate is dated 02.03.2026.

Additionally, a discrepancy has been observed in the Value of 'B' declared by the bidder. The Value of 'B' submitted during the clarification stage, as certified by the Statutory Auditor, is Rs. 1,730.62 crore, whereas the Value

of 'B' indicated in the Bid Capacity calculation sheet submitted with the original bid is Rs. 1,632.36 crore. The values are inconsistent and do not align.

In view of the above, the submission of Value of 'B' at the clarification stage, being post the Bid Due Date and inconsistent with the original bid submission, has not been considered for evaluation.

Accordingly, the bidder fails to meet the minimum Bid Capacity requirement as stipulated under Clause 2.2.2.1 of the RFP and is, therefore, considered Non-Responsive.

2. The Financial Bids of all the Responsive bidders will be opened on **24.03.2026 at 16.00 hrs** at NHAI HQ. All the Eligible bidders shall submit details for any change in their bid capacity status as per Cl. 2.2.2.1 of RFP by **23.03.2026 at 18.00 hrs**, failing which appropriate action may be taken as per RFP. It may be noted that the works for which bidder has emerged as the winner of the bids but LOA has not been issued as on the day before opening the financial bids along with other awarded/ ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of the works for which BID is invited shall also be considered while calculating value of B (value of existing commitments).

3. The bidders are required to provide following Information for updated Bid Capacity:

1. *Whether there is any change in already submitted bid capacity - Yes/No*

2. *If answer to 1 is Yes, then, please provide the following information*

a. *Details of New projects allotted like Name of Project, Date of LOA/Start/Financial Bid Opening, Value and Period of Contract, Anticipated Date of Completion etc.*

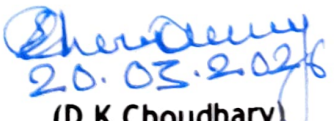
b. *Details of change in already submitted projects like change in cost (Revised Cost), change in completed value etc. Such change should be supported by authenticated supporting document and the completed value should be countersigned by the Client or its Engineer-in-charge not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent in respect of EPC Projects or Concessionaire / Authorised Signatory of SPV in respect of BOT Projects and verified by Statutory Auditor.*

Note: *The information related to updated bid capacity (new projects added or change in already submitted projects) to be provide as per format of Annex-VI to Appendix - 1A (To Calculate the Value of "B" Table).*

4. All Eligible bidders are requested to depute representative with proper authorization letter for attending the opening of Financial Bids.
