Also, even though the name of the project indicates Supervision Consultancy, the scope of work includes overall planning for project implementation, approval and construction application management, planning management, design management, contract management, tendering management, cost consulting management etc., and scope of the project consists of Highway Lighting for Bridge/Expressway/Tunnel/ Interchange Portion which may be considered at par with DPR/Feasibility Study. Additionally, the scope of work also provisions for supervision of construction including highway lighting. Therefore, the cited project may be considered as eligible project under criteria of SI. No.3 and SI. No.4 Regarding the second project cited by the bidder, "Supervision for Boutique Route Corridor Landscape Improvement Project (PingLe Avenue)" it may be noted that the same has been executed by Chongqing Liansheng Construction Project Management, which has been claimed to be part of the Bureau Veritas group of company and name of the same is mentioned in universal registration document of Bureau Veritas Group for the year 2022. Also, even though the name of the project indicates Supervision Consultancy, the scope of work includes overall planning for project implementation, approval and construction application management, planning management, design management, contract management, tendering management, cost consulting management etc., and scope of the project consists of Highway Lighting for Bridge/Expressway/Tunnel/ Interchange Portion which may be considered at par with DPR/Feasibility Study. Additionally, the scope of work also provisions for supervision of construction including highway lighting. Therefore, the cited project may be considered as eligible project under criteria of SI. No.3 and SI. No.4 Regarding the third project, "Supervision for Boutique Route Corridor Landscape Improvement Project (Yudong Avenue)" it may be noted that the Consulting fee of the assignment has been claimed as INR 3.83 Cr, which is lower than the required fee of 5 Cr and therefore, this project cannot be considered as eligible project under criteria of SI. No.3 and SI No. 4. Additionally, 2 other projects as PMC/DPR Solar Power Projects have been cited by the bidder, however the same cannot be considered as eligible projects in SI. No. 5, as they have been claimed to be implemented for Private Agencies not Government Agencies. viz., Karnataka Resco Rooftop Solar Private Limited & KOREA CARBON CO., LTD. GHG & Renewable Energy Advisory Service.

DPR/feasibility of solar power project in neither mentioned in the scope of work of the tender document nor in the experience certificate by Tiruchirappalli City Corporation. Further, no work order and Experience Certificate in this regard, has been provided by the bidder which could substantiate the claim made by the bidder. In view of the above, the cited project cannot be considered as relevant experience under Sl. No. 5 of the evaluation criteria. Additionally, 2 other projects as PMC/DPR Solar Power Projects have been cited by the bidder, however the same cannot be considered as eligible projects in Sl. No. 5, as they have been claimed to be implemented for Private Agencies not Government Agencies. viz., Karnataka Resco Rooftop Solar Private Limited & KOREA CARBON CO., LTD. GHG & Renewable Energy Advisory Service.
