1 Shiva Buildtech Private limited -Budha Infra Developers Private Limited(JV):

The other member of the bidder does not meet the minimum requirement of 20% of Technical Threshold Capacity (i.e., ₹32.80 crore) as per RFP clause 2.2.2.2 (i) and clause 2.2.2.4 (i). Accordingly, the bidder may be considered as Non-Responsive

2. Ascon Infratech Private Limited:

The bidder has not replied the clarification sought by the authority. Hence the evaluation has been done as per the clause 3.1.5 of the RFP. Accordingly. The bidder is considered as Non-Responsive.

3: HRY Kundu Buildtech Private Limited:

The bidder has claimed experience through a Joint Venture (JV); however, it is not clear whether the span work of the bridge was executed by the bidder within the JV. A clarification was sought from the bidder, who reiterated the claim of span work experience under the JV. However, no supporting documentary evidence has been submitted to establish that the span work of the bridge was actually executed by the bidder in the said JV project. In the absence of a certificate from the client clearly indicating that the span work of the bridge was executed/completed by the bidder (i.e., HRY Kundu Buildtech Private Limited), the said project has not been considered. Accordingly, the bidder is not eligible as per Clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) (a) of the RFP.

4 KRC Infraprojects Pvt Ltd.:

The bidder has claimed a project, namely, "Dembuen - Bruni", which has been executed by KRC Infraprojects (80%) alongwith Sub Contractor, namely, Drengo Construction (20%) and the Bidder along with Sub Contractor has completed several structures in that project. The bidder has submitted an experience certificate from its Client, NHIDCL, however, Experience Certificate does not specify whether the Main Contractor or Sub Contractor has finished the Project's structural works (Major Bridge/ROB/flyover having length more than or equal to 24m).

In the absence of the same, the experience of bridge length / span length cannot be given to both Main Contractor and Sub Contractor and hence, the eligibility of the bidder w.r.t. cl. 2.2.2.2 (iii) cannot be assessed. Hence, rejected and the bidder may be treated as Non-Responsive as per cl. 2.2.2.2 (iii) of the RFP Document.

2. The Financial Bids of all the Technical Responsive Bidders will be opened on **23.03.2026 at 05.00 PM** at NHAI HQ. All the Technical Responsive Bidders shall submit details for any change in their bid capacity status as per Cl. 2.2.2.1 of RFP by **23.03.2026 at 11.30 AM**, failing which appropriate action may be taken as per RFP. It may be noted that the works for which bidder has emerged as the winner of the bids but LOA has not been issued as on the day before opening the financial bids along with other awarded/ ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of the works for which BID is invited shall also be considered while calculating value of B (value of existing commitments).

3. All Technical Responsive bidders are requested to depute representative with proper authorization letter for attending the opening of Financial Bids.
