With reference to bid submitted by you regarding subject project, the responsiveness after assessing the technical evaluation of all the bidders are as under:

1.	M/s IRON Triangle Ltd.	Non-Responsive pursuant to clause 2.2.2.1 & clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) (a) of RFP	The bidder is considered non-responsive due to the following reasons: a. Bid Capacity The bidder is considered non-responsive as it does not meet the Bid Capacity criteria pursuant to Clause 2.2.2.1 of the RFP, which states: "Bidders who inter alia meet the minimum qualification criteria will be qualified only if their available Bid Capacity is more than the total Bid value (value as per Clause 1.1.1)." As per the provisions of the RFP, the bidder is required to furnish supporting documents/certificates for ongoing commitments (value of 'B') duly countersigned by the Client or its Engineer-in-Charge (not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent) for EPC projects, or by the Concessionaire/Authorized Signatory of SPV for BOT projects, indicating the amount of work completed or the balance value of work. Upon evaluation of the bid and the subsequent clarification submitted by the bidder, it has been observed that some of the certificates submitted are not signed by the competent authority as required under the RFP. Based on the information and documents made available, the available Bid Capacity of the bidder has been calculated as Rs. (-) 2.67 crore, which is lower than the required Bid Capacity of Rs. 109.971 crore. In view of the above, the bidder fails to meet the Bid Capacity criteria as per Clause 2.2.2.1 of the RFP. b. Similar Completed Project (Annexure IX) (Clause 2.2.2.2 (iii)) In order to claim a Similar Completed Project, the bidder is required to provide the project details in the format prescribed under Annexure IX of the RFP.

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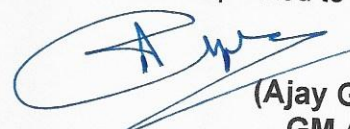

			Upon examination of the bid, it was observed that the self-certificate submitted by the bidder did not contain the detailed project execution information in the prescribed format and instead mentioned "Completion Certificate Attached." Accordingly, the bidder was requested to resubmit Annexure IX in full conformity with the RFP format, including all required details. However, in its clarification reply, the bidder has again submitted a revised Experience Certificate in the format of Annexure IX without providing the required detailed project execution information, and the remark "Completion Certificate Attached" has again been mentioned. As per the provisions of the RFP, bidders are required to submit Annexure IX in the prescribed format, including complete project execution details, to substantiate their claim of having executed a Similar Completed Project. Since the revised submission does not conform to the prescribed Annexure IX format and the required project execution details have not been furnished, the bidder's claim for a Similar Completed Project cannot be considered for evaluation.
2.	M/s Maan Builders Pvt. Ltd.	Non-Responsive pursuant to clause 2.2.2.1 & of RFP	The bidder is considered Non-Responsive as it does not meet the Bid Capacity criteria pursuant to Clause 2.2.2.1 of the RFP, which states: <i>"Bidders who inter alia meet the minimum qualification criteria will be qualified only if their available Bid Capacity is more than the total Bid value (value as per Clause 1.1.1)."</i> As per the provisions of the RFP, the bidder is required to furnish supporting documents/certificates for ongoing commitments (value of 'B') duly countersigned by the Client or its Engineer-in-Charge (not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent) for EPC projects, or by the Concessionaire/Authorized Signatory of SPV for BOT projects, indicating the amount of work completed or the balance value of work. Upon evaluation of the bid and the subsequent clarification submitted by the bidder, it has been observed that some of the certificates submitted are not signed by the competent authority or value of work done/ completed mentioned in Annex IV are not in consonance with value of work done certified by client. Based on the information and documents made available, the available Bid Capacity of the bidder has been calculated as Rs. 81.56 crore, which is lower than the required Bid Capacity of Rs. 109.971 crore. In view of the above, the bidder fails to meet the Bid Capacity criteria as per Clause 2.2.2.1 of the RFP.
3.	M/s Rajbir Construction Pvt. Ltd.	Responsive	Eligible for Financial Opening
4.	M/s Ram Chandra Paul	Non-Responsive pursuant to clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) (a) of RFP	The bidder is considered Non-Responsive, as the bidder does not meet the eligibility criteria specified under Clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) (a) of the RFP regarding Similar Completed Project. The bidder has claimed Project Code "B" (Nandakumar-Contai-Digha-Chandaneswar, NH-116B) executed in Joint Venture as Lead Member with 60% share. As per the certificate submitted, the ROB consists of 18 spans of 25 m and 03 spans

			of 37.2 m (steel composite girder as per RDSO standards) with an overall length of 561.60 m and ROB cost of Rs. 52.18 Cr. During evaluation, it was not clear whether the bidder itself had executed the ROB works. Accordingly, clarification was sought. In response, the bidder submitted a client certificate stating that the Lead Member executed 03 spans of 37.2 m composite girder and 09 spans of 25 m viaduct (including RE Wall). The submitted details satisfy the span and structure length requirements of the RFP. However, the cost of execution of the structure work by the bidder itself, duly certified by the Executive Engineer/competent authority, has not been provided as required under the RFP. In the absence of the certified cost details, the bidder's claim for the Similar Completed Project cannot be substantiated.

6.	M/s Triveni Engicons Private Limited	Responsive	Eligible for Financial Opening
7	M/s JKA Associates Pvt. Ltd.	Responsive	Eligible for Financial Opening
8	M/s HRY Kundu Buildtech Private Limited	Non-Responsive pursuant to clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) (a) of RFP	The bidder is considered Non-Responsive, as the bidder does not meet the eligibility criteria specified under Clause 2.2.2.2 (iii) (a) of the RFP regarding Similar Completed Project. Upon evaluation, it was observed that none of the projects claimed by the bidder satisfy the required criteria with respect to span, structure length, and project cost as stipulated under the above clause. Accordingly, clarification was sought from the bidder. Further, certain additional deficiencies were observed in the documents submitted with the bid, for which clarifications were also sought. The details of these issues are provided in Annexure A of this report. However, no response has been received from the bidder against the clarification sought. Therefore, in the absence of the required clarifications and supporting documents, the bidder fails to establish compliance with the RFP requirements.

2. In this regard, it is intimated that financial bids for the above-mentioned responsive bidders (after ascertaining the updated bid capacity as on the day before opening the financial bids) will be opened on 23.03.2026 at 11:00 Hrs. at NHAI HQ. All qualified bidders are requested to make it convenient to attend the same.
