2	Bidders are permitted to form consortium/Joint Venture. The clauses as given below shall be applicable for consortium (Joint Venture). In case of a consortium (Joint Venture, certified copy of the agreement between various partners shall be submitted with the tender. i) The consortium (Joint Venture shall nominate a Representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the members of the JV during the bidding process and, in the event the JV is awarded the Contract, during contract execution. ii) The consortium (Joint Venture will identify a lead partner who will be authorized to execute the contract with the department.
