16. INITIAL OBSERVATIONS :

- a It is submitted that in CPPP portal there is a feature of Bid Auto Extension Corrigendum wherein the tenders can be Configured to be opened on receipt of specified number of bids and in the absence of the minimum configured bids the CPPP portal itself issues a Bid Auto Extension Corrigendum as per the configured Days for Bid Submission Closing Date and Tender Opening Date. It is further submitted that there is no provision to view the number of bids which have been submitted against each tender in the CPPP e-procurement portal. In case of non-receipt of minimum configured bids Bid auto Extension corrigendum is issued by the servers on 03 iterations and in case of receipt of minimum configured bids the case is forwarded to bid openers login wherein the bids can be opened on the stipulated tender opening date and time and only then the total number of bids received against the tender are visible. After 03 Bid auto extensions the e-bids received (if any) are forwarded to the bid openers login
- b The Configuration of minimum number of bids and number of days to be extended in HVF tenders as configured is as follows

- d On opening of tender box on 19-03-2026 (3rd auto extended bid submission closing date), it is seen that no EMD was found submitted .
- e On Opening of the tender in CPPP portal on 20-03-2026, it is found that there was only one response / bid submitted by M/s. Sundew Chemicals And Systems, Chennai
- f It is submitted that the case has become a Resultant Single Tender (**RST**). It is submitted that Cl. No. 10.4.5 of the SOP for Civil Works in AVNL – 2024 states that Single Offer / Resultant Single Tender shall be re-tendered after analysing the reasons in relevant CWC.

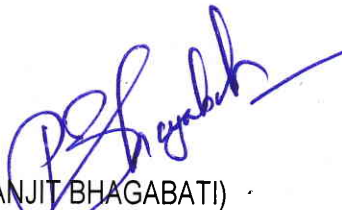

- c CWC-II also observed that in this tender, on the Original bid submission closing date as well as extended bid submission closing dates, the minimum configured number of bids / offers were not received. The CPPP portal has issued Bid Auto Extension Corrigendum on 03 Iterations. It is submitted that on the 03rd extended bid submission closing date, no further auto extension corrigendum is issued by the portal since it is configured only for 03 Auto Extensions.
- d CWC-II noted that on opening of tender box on 19-03-2026 (3rd auto extended bid submission closing date), it is seen that no EMD was found submitted .
- e CWC-II also noted that on opening of the tender in CPPP portal on 20-03-2026, it is found that there was only one response / bid submitted by M/s. Sundew Chemicals And Systems, Chennai
- f CWC-II finally observed that the case has become a Resultant Single Tender (**RST**). It is submitted that Cl. No. 10.4.5 of the SOP for Civil Works in AVNL – 2024 states that Single Offer / Resultant Single Tender shall be re-tendered after analysing the reasons in relevant CWC.



1/ **DECISION OF CWC-II HELD ON 25-03-2026 :**

- a. CWC-II observed that the case has become a Resultant Single Tender (RST), since only one response / bid submitted by M/s. Sundew Chemicals and Systems, Chennai has been received. CWC-II noted that Cl. No. 10.4.5 of the SOP for Civil Works in AVNL – 2024 states that Single Offer / Resultant Single Tender shall be re-tendered .
- b. In order to increase the number of participants, CWC-II decided to change the Pre-Qualification criteria from (similar work means – Supply and Fixing / Operation and Maintenance of Water Supply (and / or) Reverse Osmosis Plants only) to (similar work means – Supply and Fixing / Operation and Maintenance of Water Supply / Reverse Osmosis Plants (AND / OR) any Civil Works Only).
- c. In view of the above, CWC-II decided that the case should be re-tendered on Open Tender basis, with Two Part Bid System through e-Procurement Portal (CPPP) with eligibility criteria as (Similar Work means Supply and Fixing / Operation and Maintenance of Water Supply / Reverse Osmosis Plants (AND / OR) any Civil Works Only) and the present e-tender bearing tender ID: 2026_AVNL_265224_1 must be cancelled in the e-procurement portal (CPPP).
