Bidder did not submit the complete affidavit on mandatory declarations of the eligibility defined in NIT (Appendix-III) - Exhibit-I which is a mandatory qualification condition. 2. The bidder does not possess adequate manpower, equipment, tools and plants in quantities equal to or exceeding those stipulated in the NIT, which is a mandatory eligibility requirement. The bidder failed to submit experience certificates, payroll records of the engineers engaged by them, and documentary evidence of ownership/possession of the required tools, plants and equipment, such as purchase invoices, insurance documents, lease agreements, or other relevant supporting documents. 3. The bidders did not respond to the Corporation's query and failed to rectify the above deficiencies despite being provided an opportunity of seven (7) days to submit the requisite documents before the final evaluation.

Accordingly, the said engineer is not eligible for consideration, resulting in the bidder failing to meet the minimum manpower eligibility requirement.

Bidder did not submit the CA certificate, client experience certificate in support of ambiguous private works experience credential declared by him in PQ forms against the eligibility requirement. 2. Bidder does not possess the Engineers and Equipment, Tools and Plants in the quantity required and stipulated in the NIT which is a mandatory eligibility requirement. Bidder did not submit the experience certificate, pay role documents of engineers available with them. 3. Despite being granted an opportunity of seven (7) days to clarify the deficiencies and submit the requisite supporting documents before the final evaluation, the bidder did not respond to the Corporation's query and did not furnish the required information/documents.

The bidder failed to submit experience certificates, payroll records of the engineers engaged by them, and documentary evidence of ownership/possession of the required tools, plants and equipment, such as purchase invoices, insurance documents, lease agreements, or other relevant supporting documents. 3. The bidder does not have an adequate number of qualified engineers, equal to or exceeding the minimum requirement stipulated in the NIT. One of the proposed Site Engineer possesses a B.E. degree in Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE), whereas the NIT specifically requires Site Engineers to hold qualifications in Civil or Electrical Engineering. Accordingly, the said engineer is not eligible for

		consideration, resulting in the bidder failing to meet the minimum manpower eligibility requirement. 2. Bidder does not have enough Equipment (minimum 2 power trowel) as the document for only one power trowel could be arranged even vide an opportunity of 7 days given to submit the documents in support of it ownership/possession.
