

**FINAL TEC RECOMMENDATION FOR SERVICE / REPAIR OF CRANE INSTALLED IN CPB
I, II & IV FOR FY 2025-26 AT NW-2**

NIT for Service / Repair of crane installed in CPB I, II & IV for FY 2025-26 at NW-2 was published on 12th January 2026 on IWA website and e-procurement portal. In response to NIT, following 04 (four) bidders had submitted their bids on the scheduled date and time i.e., 02nd February 2026 at 1230 hrs, which is the last date of submission of the offers:

1. M/s Vivira Projects Pvt. Ltd., Guwahati. (1/4)
2. M/s All Hydraulic Service, New Delhi. (2/4)
3. M/s Ashok Marketing Company, West Bengal. (3/4)
4. M/s B.K. Associates, Pathshala, Assam. (4/4)

Accordingly, a technical comparative statement has been prepared and enclosed as Annex-1.

As per the observations of the TEC during preparation of the comparative statement, M/s B.K. Associates, Pathshala, Assam (4/4) has submitted all the mandatory documents, viz. MSME certificate, audited balance sheet, experience certificate, tender document duly stamped and signed by the firm, current solvency certificate, details of tools and plants, etc. The firm HAS adequate experience and may be considered technically qualified.

Further, with reference to the shortfall documents sought from M/s Vivira Projects Pvt. Ltd (1/4), M/s All Hydraulic Service, New Delhi (2/4), and M/s Ashok Marketing Company, West Bengal (3/4), it is observed that only two bidders have successfully submitted the requisite documents, such as Registration/Incorporation Certificate of the Company, ESIC & EPFO registration certificates, Annual Turnover Certificate for the last three years (duly certified by a Chartered Accountant with UDIN), details of tools and plants, technical supervisory personnel list, etc. These firms also possess adequate experience and may be considered technically qualified.

M/s All Hydraulic Service, New Delhi (2/4) failed to submit the required documents as per the technical qualification criteria, i.e. Bank Solvency Certificate, similar work experience, and UDIN mentioned on the Balance Sheets for FY 2021-22 and 2023-24. Hence, the bidder is technically disqualified

Accordingly, the TEC recommends that three out of four bidders, namely M/s Vivira Projects Pvt. Ltd (1/4), M/s Ashok Marketing Company, West Bengal (3/4), and M/s B.K. Associates, Pathshala, Assam (4/4), be considered technically qualified. Hence, the financial bids of all the technically qualified bidders may be opened.
